1. Resilience and Readiness (500 word limit)

Describe the major challenges you've faced on your path to graduation, how you overcame them, what you learned about yourself, and how these experiences prepare you for college, training, or a career.

2. Pride and Accomplishment (500 word limit)

Share an accomplishment you're truly proud of — from school, athletics, family, community service, or elsewhere — and explain what motivates you and why it matters.

3. What Makes You Stand Out (250 word limit)

What makes you unique compared to your peers? Consider your personality, interests, experiences, or values — anything that shows who you are and what makes you, you.

4. Future Plans and Dreams (500 word limit)

What are your future plans and dreams? What are your thoughts about college or a career? How have you prepared yourself to take the next steps?

5. Impact of the Scholarship (500 word limit)

	One letter of recommendation from a <u>school representative</u> (this can be a teacher, counselor, principal, FAN Advocate, coach, etc.)
	One letter of recommendation from a <u>person in the community who knows you well</u> (this can be a friend, co-worker, supervisor, member of church or club, etc.)
	Transcript - It is important for us to understand your ability to succeed in a rigorous academic setting like college, university or a trade school so we want you to submit a copy of your transcript. (If you don't know how to do this, please see your counselor).
	FAFSA/ORSAA - It is important for us to understand your financial situation and your family's ability to contribute to your continuing education so we want you to submit a copy of your FAFSA Report/Student Aid Index or ORSAA. (If you don't know how to do this, please see your counselor).
