### **Who can apply?**

- ✓ Students in a household currently receiving assistance through the Housing Authority of Travis County
- ✓ Graduating high school seniors (Class of 2026)
- ✓ Students planning to attend college, trade, or technical school in Fall 2026

### **Scholarship Award Amount**

\$2,500 to each awarded applicant

### **Application Deadline**

**May 7, 2026 – by 5:00 PM**
