5. Each applicant must submit a 1-page essay containing a brief biographical sketch, educational aspirations, career goals, and an explanation of why financial aid is essential. (Typed, double-spaced, not to exceed two (2) pages.
6. List of extracurricular and community activities you have or are involved in (if applicable).
7. If selected for a grant, a digital photo is required for our Dinner Journal
8. Students have one year to redeem the scholarship award from the date of notification.

**Any application received incompletely will be automatically disqualified**

**If selected, applicants will be asked to submit a national application for additional scholarship opportunities**
