

Dear WHMI Family,

We are now halfway through 2025, and we have much to give thanks for and much for which to work and pray. Q2 closed with some notable milestones: we now have more than 10,000 active students and more than 5,000 graduates. The work continues to replicate, fueled by national leadership. To date we have already taught approximately 683 courses, of which at least 90% were taught by nationals. Location numbers also continue to rise (329 with 57 additional locations in trial). In summary, we have lots of work and lots of potential work on the horizon. Our challenge remains ensuring we have adequate funding. We still need around \$700,000 to finish out this year and we need additional funds to make sure we can avoid slowing down growth. We are managing expenses to a tight overall 10% reduction in the approved budget. Meanwhile we are working on multiple fronts to secure sufficient funding to underwrite this amazing growth.

Our Board Chair, Laura Sorrell, recently joined me, Wes White, and my wife, Amy, in Africa. We officiated and celebrated 3 graduations and opened a 5th generation Bible Institute in Kawangware! Laura saw and felt the work as she fully immersed herself in the people and the places. After her visit, we began to discuss another challenge that lies before us.

While the statistics above are amazing (nothing short of a God-given miracle), a gap remains between what the statistics show and the extraordinary movement that is happening in communities around the world. We continue to ponder how to close this gap with ideas ranging from making sure as many as possible are on the field (no real substitute for that), to a longer documentary chronicling the transformation we know is happening in churches and communities, to ways in which we as ambassadors talk about and describe our ministry and its impact. This is, perhaps, the single largest challenge we are facing, one that will require prayer, wisdom, discernment, and creativity. We know for certain; the story of the people, churches, and communities being transformed by the power of the gospel must be told. The investment in trained pastors and church leaders around the world accomplishes an essential part of the Great Commission and enhances all aspects of building the Kingdom for Christ!

Finally, we remain in a posture of prayer concerning multiple human needs within our WHMI Family. The death of Kitty Sandel was a gut punch for many of us. Kitty distinguished herself as an extraordinary team member in her 14 years at WHMI. Additionally, Bryan Davis, son of Dwight and Linda, remains in a very difficult situation following an acute stroke earlier in July (he needs a miracle). And one of our dedicated Board members continues to face ongoing treatment for cancer. Beyond that, we are aware of multiple needs in our greater WHMI Global Family. It seems our WHMI Family is carrying an increased burden. Perhaps you are as well. All of us have life happening around us. In the middle of such growth and hard work to keep it going, please remember to pray for our entire WHMI Family.
