Due to the natural lag in data received from locations around the world, these figures reflect information available at the time of reporting. In addition, each year, a mid-year location data audit is conducted to review and validate location records and confirm operational status. As a result, the status of certain locations or countries and the number of engaged students may be updated based on the audit findings. WHMI remains committed to efficiently and intentionally gathering data and testimonies from around the world so that the story of what God is doing can be shared and praised. We believe this is essential to being a ministry that people can trust and more importantly, one that honors the Lord.
