Our History

2008

The founding of Jesuit Refugee Service Ukraine. We opened our doors to refugees from Iran, Iraq, Syria, Somalia, Palestine, Afghanistan, as well as Uyghurs from China.



2014

We began welcoming Ukrainians — internally displaced persons from the Donetsk and Luhansk regions.



2022

Our shelter began welcoming people from all parts of Ukraine. We also opened a second shelter in Bryukhovychi. During the first six months, 600 people passed through our shelters.



2025

We operate a shelter in Lviv, supported by a team of 10 people, with over 10 areas of activity, serving both the city of Lviv and the Lviv region.

About Us

In 2025, JRS Ukraine continued to accompany, support, and advocate for **people forcibly displaced by the Russian war against Ukraine.**

We strive to create conditions for a dignified life, recovery, and integration of people into host communities.

In our work, we combine **emergency assistance, psychosocial support, shelter, legal aid, education, integration, and advocacy.**

Who We Supported

The majority of our beneficiaries were internally displaced persons from frontline and temporarily occupied regions of Ukraine:
Donetsk, Luhansk, Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia, and Kherson regions.

Many people experienced repeated displacement and prolonged stress, as well as the loss of their homes and stability.

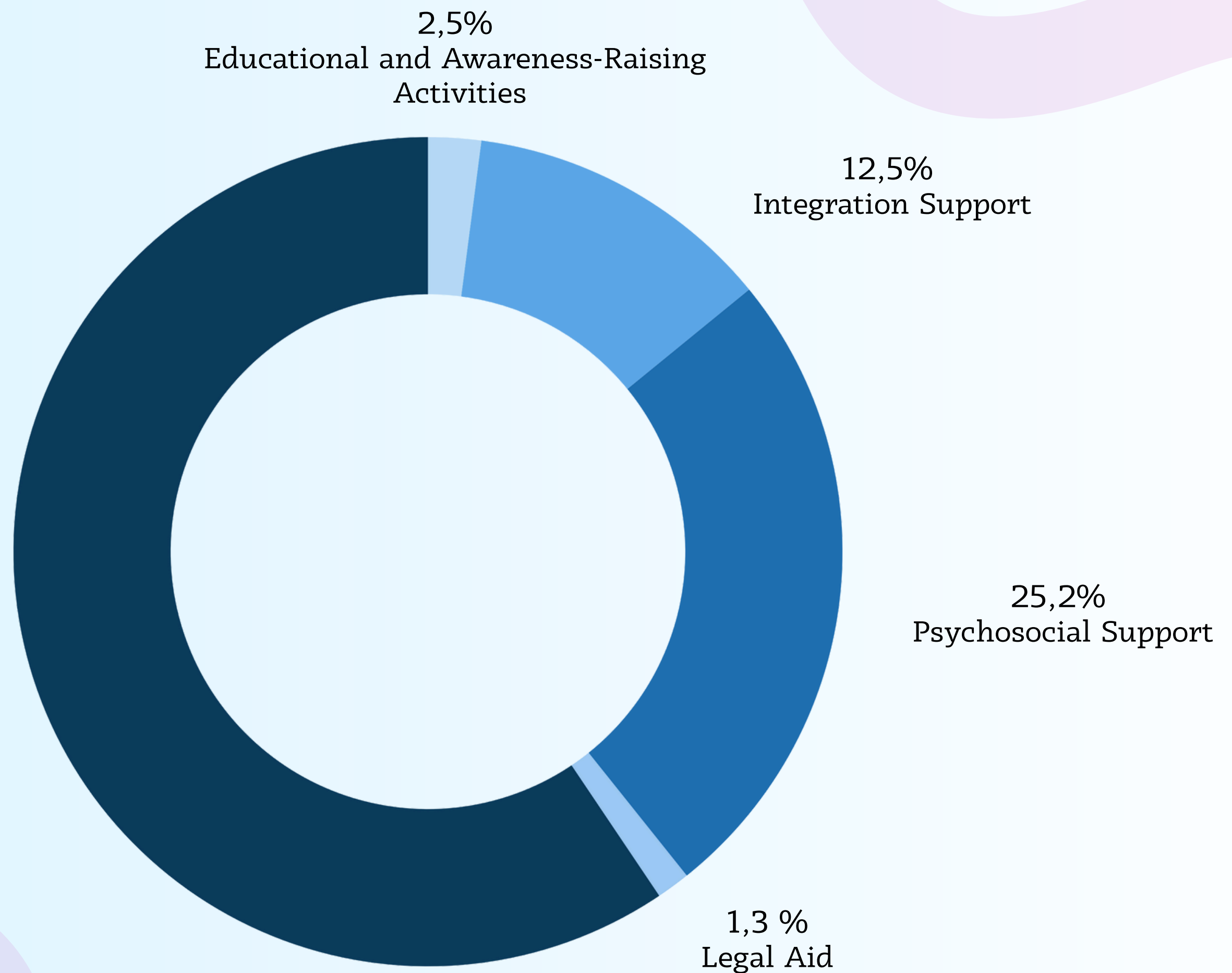

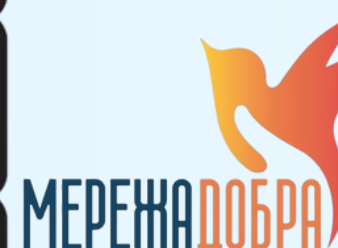
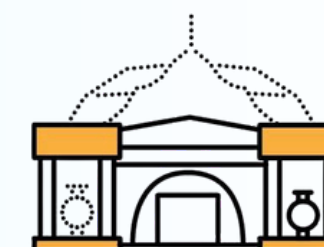
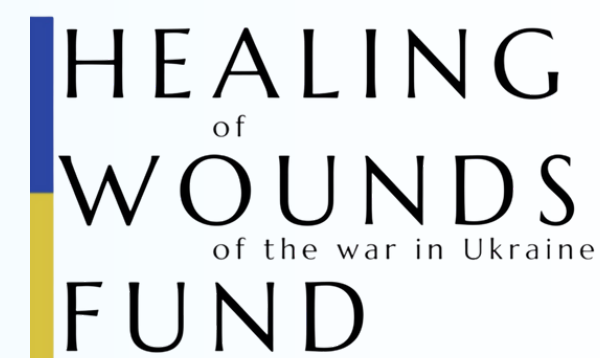


Highlights of 2025
