

He swims Butterfly and Medley, and is celebrated for his determination, skill, and inspiring journey to success on the world stage. Today he inspired our students with an engaging presentation and answered their questions about what motivates him as a professional swimmer, as well sharing with us all about what it means to chase your dreams, being an Olympian and what it's like to be in the olympic village, his weekly swim training schedule and how to fuel his body with his food intake. He then led a masterclass for our competitive swim squad, which was incredible, some of our squad even had the confidence to race against him! His visit gave students a unique opportunity to learn from his experiences at the highest level of competition, while gaining valuable insights into training, perseverance, and the mindset needed to succeed in sport and beyond. It was an incredibly inspiring opportunity to hear about grit, determination and perseverance, our swim squad were honoured to meet him.
