### Selichot Visit to Maghain Aboth Synagogue

Students from Grades 3 to 10 who participate in daily tefila gathered early in the morning on Tuesday at the Maghain Aboth Synagogue for a Selichot service, a special prayer recited in the days between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. They joined wholeheartedly in the prayers and sang familiar melodies with great enthusiasm. The service reached a moving climax with the sounding of the shofar. Afterwards, the students shared breakfast together, making it a meaningful and memorable experience for all who attended.

### Grade 1 Sign Language Lesson

The Grade 1 class were happy to welcome Ms. Rosalind Foo to teach our

manner. As Ms. Foo introduced them to basic signs, the students eagerly practiced using their hands and facial expressions to convey thoughts and feelings. They learnt that communication isn't just about sound, it also involves visual cues and body language. This interactive experience not only expanded their understanding of language, but also fostered empathy and appreciation for those who are deaf or hard of hearing, making them more aware of the diverse ways people connect with one another.

## Grade 2 Chinatown Field Trip

As part of our IPC unit *Different Places, Similar Lives*, Grade 2 went on an exciting field trip to Chinatown. Students explored important landmarks such as Thian Hock Keng Temple, Nagore Dargah, Ann Siang Hill, the Buddha Tooth Relic Temple, and even discovered an old well that gave them a glimpse into life in the past. Along the way, they learnt about Singapore's rich cultural diversity and how traditions and daily life in Chinatown connect with communities around the world. A big thank you to our wonderful parent volunteers, whose support helped make this meaningful learning journey possible!
