Inclusive Learning in Action: Our Community Visit to SG Assist

We were very proud of our Student Councillors from Grade 3 to 10 this week, who spent a meaningful Wednesday morning at the SG Assist Age+ Living Lab. Senior volunteers aged in their 50s to 70s, co-presented and then demonstrated various gerontechnology tools that are used in daily caregiving. Our students had the opportunity to listen, to ask questions and to experience the items hands-on, helping them to understand the real, every day, challenges seniors face, and learn how technology can support senior's independence, safety and quality of life. This direct interaction not only built empathy and awareness in our students but also forms an important foundation for their upcoming Reminiscence Project, where students will engage seniors through stories, conversations and shared experiences in the coming months. The visit was organised by Ms Buvanes from the Inclusion Team, with support from Mr Euan, Ms Angelina and Mr Steven.




