ACCESS AND ADMIN INFO
Make sure you have access to.
Website platform/CMS login (e.g. WordPress, Webflow, Shopify)
Domain registrar (e.g. GoDaddy, Namecheap)
Website hosting account (if separate)
Google Analytics and/or Tag Manager
Email marketing platform (e.g. Mailchimp, Klaviyo)
Ad platform or Meta Pixel account (if relevant)
BRAND ASSETS
Gather your core brand materials.
Logo files (SVG or high-res PNG)
Color palette and brand fonts
Brand guidelines or style guide
Approved photography or stock image library
Icons, illustrations, or design elements
