WHAT IS ACCESS FRAMINGHAM?

Framingham Public Access Corporation (FPAC) dba Access Framingham Television (AFTV) is a non-profit corporation designated by the City of Framingham to run Access Framingham Television. AFTV also manages the Framingham Education Channel (FECtv). The organization has historically been anchored to cable access television. Today it offers much more and continues to adapt to an ever evolving streaming and mobile media landscape.

We reach our community through Access Framingham, FECtv - Framingham Education Channel, and The Frame.
