



For Immediate Release – May 24, 2026

At approximately 4:45am on May 24, 2026, Pine Cliff Energy became aware of a crude oil release at one of our well sites located approximately seven kilometres north of Sundre, Alberta. Residents in the area reported a strong odour in the area.

We understand this would have been concerning for nearby residents, and our immediate priority has been the safety of residents, the community, our workers, and the environment.

Our emergency response procedures were activated immediately. The well was shut in, and air monitoring equipment has been deployed. Notifications have been made to local residents, the Alberta Energy Regulator, and other appropriate authorities. No evacuations were required.

We have yet to detect any sour gas but will continue to monitor on a precautionary basis. While some oil odour may still be noticeable in the immediate area, ongoing monitoring indicates there is no risk to public health or safety.

It is still too early to confirm the exact volume released; however, current indications are that the volume was limited. We continue to work closely and cooperatively with regulatory, environmental, health, and emergency response agencies as response and investigation efforts continue.

Our primary focus is cleaning up the affected area as quickly and safely as possible to prevent any further impact on local residents, land, wildlife, or the environment.

We are committed to keeping the community informed and will provide an update as more information becomes available.
