

SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

THE KINGDOM IS REAL: WEEK 2

*While anyone can take time to answer these questions individually, these questions are best discussed in a group! Not in a group yet? We want you in one! Head over to **southeastchristian.org** to join a group in person or online, wherever you are - today!*

What would you do if you suddenly had a billion dollars? How would that change the way you make decisions? How would it change your priorities? In what ways do our resources determine our limitations? How can a lack of resources keep us from doing what we want to do (or even what we should do)?

Read Acts 3:1-16. What happened when Peter and John went to the Temple to worship? What miracle did they perform there? How did the crowd react to what they saw? How did this miraculous occurrence give them an opportunity to preach the Gospel?

Trip reminded us that the King shares His power. As Christians, how would you describe the power we have available to us? How has God empowered/equipped us through His Spirit? How has He empowered/equipped us through His Word? What are some of the obstacles that keep us from tapping into that power?

What did the lame man initially ask Peter and John for (Acts 3:3)? How did they ultimately give him something even greater than what he wanted? Has there ever been a time in your life when God didn't give you what you asked for because He had something better in mind? How should we respond in those moments?

Jesus shares His power with us so that we can share the Gospel with others. How can we connect other people with the love and grace of Jesus? What does that look like in our workplace? Our communities? Our everyday lives? What are some situations/places where you desperately need His power to work through you?

As you close your time together, read 2 Timothy 1:7. How does Paul describe the Spirit God has given us? What would living in this way look like on a practical level? How would you live differently this week if you lived in the reality of that Spirit? Pray that God would help you to live this week according to the Spirit He has given you.
