Topic: Living as God's Children

Embracing Our Identity as God's Children [Ephesians 3:14-15]

- 1. Recognizing our adoption into God's family
- 2. Understanding the privileges and responsibilities of being God's children
- 3. Cultivating a deep sense of belonging and security in our relationship with God

Living in the Love of the Father [Ephesians 3:16-17a]

- 1. Experiencing the unconditional love of God
- 2. Allowing God's love to transform our hearts and minds
- 3. Extending God's love to others through our words and actions

Growing in the Fullness of God [Ephesians 3:17b]

- 1. Seeking a deeper intimacy with God through prayer and study of His Word
- 2. Allowing the Holy Spirit to work in us and conform us to the image of Christ
- 3. Pursuing spiritual maturity and becoming more like our Heavenly Father
