Matthew 18:15-20

Summary: This outline focuses on the themes of reconciliation, agreement, and God's presence, while incorporating the suggested points of starting with the same letter or having a similar structure.

Topic: The Concern to Win over the Brother or Sister that Reflects God's Own Passion that 'None Should be Lost'

The Call to Reconciliation [Matthew 18:15-17]

1. Recognizing the importance of addressing conflicts within the church
2. Resolving issues through direct communication and love
3. Seeking restoration and unity within the body of Christ

The Power of Agreement [Matthew 18:18-19]

1. Understanding the authority given to believers in binding and loosing
2. Praying together in agreement for the reconciliation of others
3. Trusting in God's promise to be present when two or more are gathered

The Assurance of God's Presence [Matthew 18:20]

1. Emphasizing the significance of gathering in Jesus' name
2. Experiencing the tangible presence of God in our midst

3. Encouraging a community that reflects God's love and grace
