Temporary Protection That Removes With Ease

PROCESSING RECOMMENDATIONS

U-Mask-It (High Density) is specially formulated for use on rough or uneven surfaces, including stone, concrete, brick, tile, wood, stucco and more. For optimal results, apply this formula after applying four coats of U-Mask-It original formula. For best results, store and apply at room temperature (73°F / 23°C). Do not allow the product to freeze, as frozen material cannot be used. Use within 12 months of purchase. Keep in mind—cooler temperatures will slow the cure time, while warmer conditions will speed it up. Always wear safety glasses, long sleeves, and rubber gloves to protect yourself and prevent contamination. Test on a small area before applying. U-Mask-It may leave residue on some surfaces and should never be used on fabric or carpet.

How to Apply and Remove U-Mask-It

Application Tools

- Start with a clean surface, then use masking tape to mask off outside edges of work area.
- Best results: use a high density foam roller. Alternatives: a brush or putty knife.

First 4 Coats

- Apply a thin, even first coat of U-Mask-It (original formula) to create a base layer. Follow this with four additional coats to build the foundation.
- Allow each coat to dry until tacky. (Drying time may vary depending on temperature and humidity.)

Building Layers On Rough or Uneven Surfaces

- Continue by now applying layers of **U-Mask-It (High Density)** until the rough surface is sufficiently coated to prevent any bleed-through of your coloring.
- The exact number of coats depends on your material's texture, working conditions, and how evenly you apply the product.

Painting

- Once your masking layers are complete, apply your paint/color and let it dry.

Removal

- Peel U-Mask-It off slowly by pulling it back.
- If peeling is difficult, apply one more coat, let it dry, and then peel again.
- **Important:** Do not leave U-Mask-It on for more than 12 hours after your paint has dried since it may cure in place and shrink or become difficult to remove, depending on conditions.

SAFETY FIRST

BE CAREFUL – Do not use if you have known latex allergies. Avoid contact with eyes. If contact occurs, flush with water for 15 minutes and seek medical attention. For skin contact, clean with a waterless hand cleaner, then wash with soap and water. Children should only use this product under adult supervision.
