#### **Welcome to CC!**

Welcome! You are receiving this newsletter if you have an incoming 9th grade student who will be participating in our Commitment Class program for the 2025-26 year. We are so excited for the year ahead with our 9th graders!

#### What we do

Commitment Class is a unique experience for students to dig into their faith and begin to explore what they believe and why. Our mission in Student Ministries is to inspire students to develop lifelong relationships with Jesus. Our hope is that through this year in Commitment Class, students would feel invited into this every time we gather.

Every Wednesday night, our program will consist of large group time and small group time. Large group will include times of games, worship, and teachings, while small groups allow students the chance to create community, process through the teaching together, and ask questions.

Each small group is led by a committed adult leader who genuinely cares about walking alongside students as they explore and grow in their faith. One of the most meaningful aspects of the year is watching the relationships between students and their leaders deepen over time. In addition to their small group leader, students will also have opportunities throughout the year to connect with various mentors who are farther along in their own faith journey. These mentors include senior adults, college students, and CPC staff. Our hope behind this is that it would give students an opportunity to hear from different people about what it looks like to follow Jesus in many different stages of life and lines of work. The rest of the time, students will be with their small group and leader, who will be assigned to them at the beginning of the year.

#### Sign Up

ALL 9th graders must sign up for Commitment Class. This helps us make sure that we have your updated contact information, that we know who to reach out to in case of an emergency, and that we place your student in the right small group.
