CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: We pray trusting in Your forgiveness because of the love You demonstrated in Your Son's life, death, and resurrection. Sin has no power to rule when we fully surrender ourselves to Jesus.

Unison: **Open our hearts to the guidance of Your Spirit, that all of life may be all for Jesus. Amen.**
