

ACTIVITY UPDATE

We would like to provide more detail to the community regarding upcoming activities at the Mine Site Complex (MSC) area taking place over the next few weeks.

Lake Geotechnical Program:

- Mobilization is expected to begin this weekend at the pull-out at the end of the lake. Work on the lake will begin on approximately August 10 and may take up to 14 days.
- Work will be done from a deck barge that will be launched using a shore-based crane. There will be no public access to the pull-out during the unloading/loading of the barge at the start and end of the program. Please follow posted signage.
- A temporary floating dock will be installed to provide personnel access to the barge and to minimize shoreline disturbance.
- Please refer to the image (right) which outlines the areas where work will be taking place.

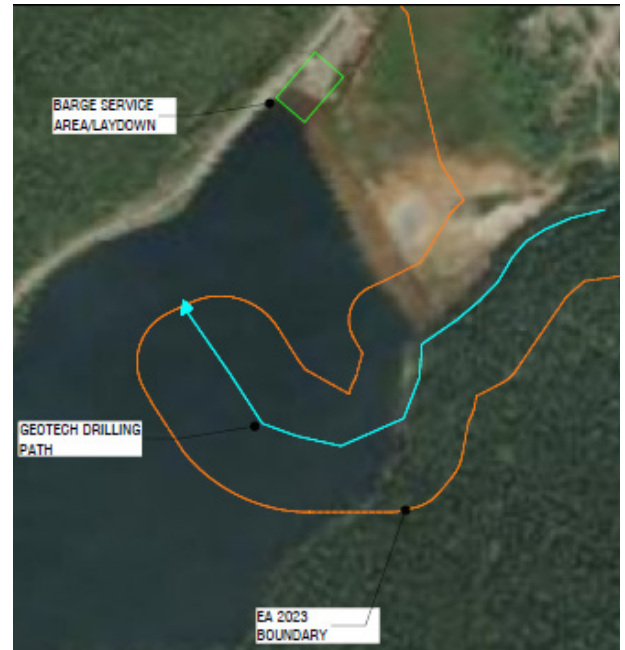
