

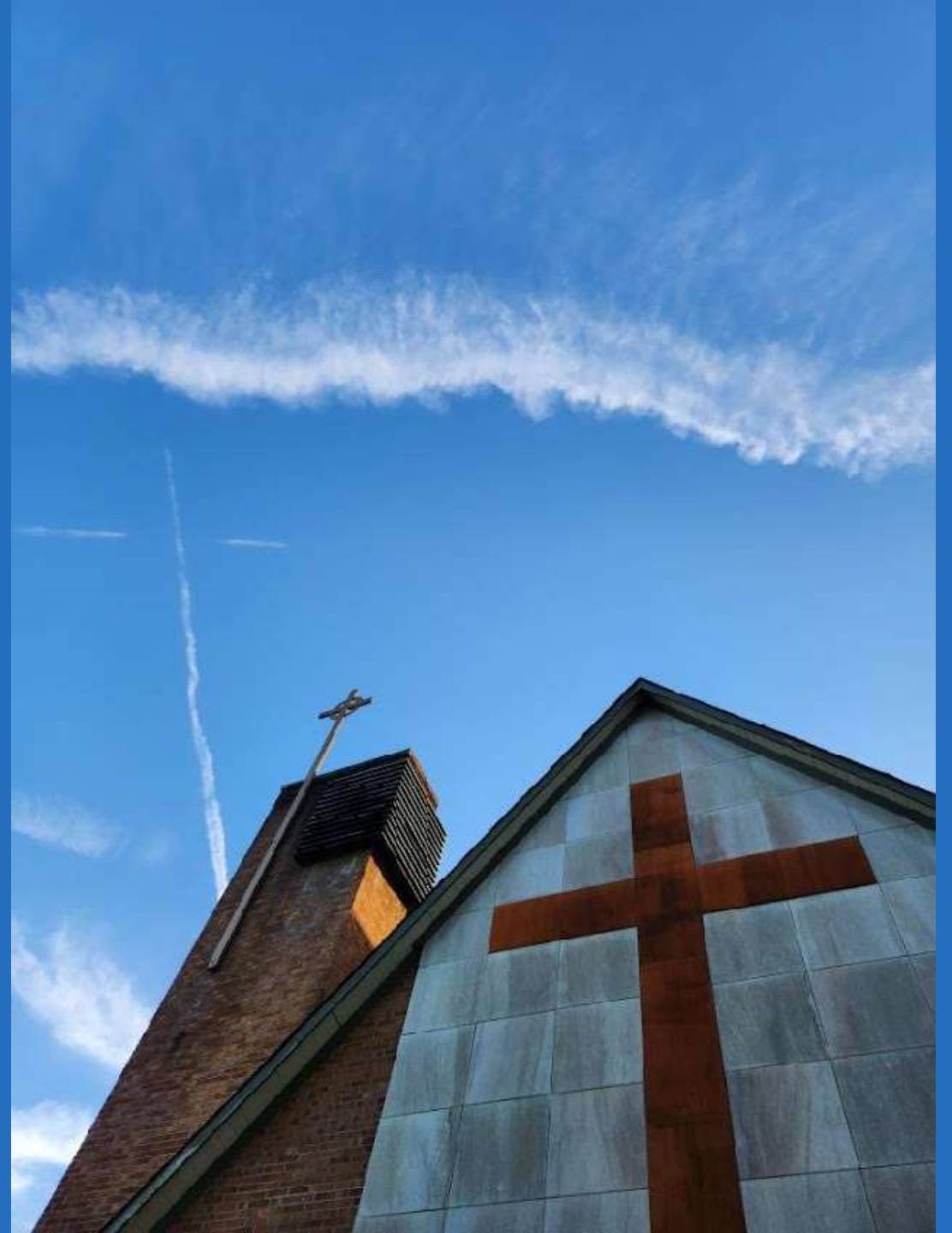

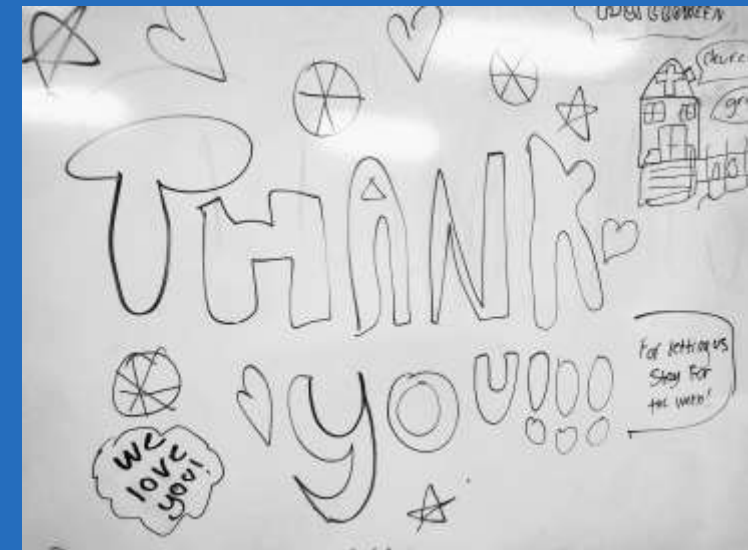

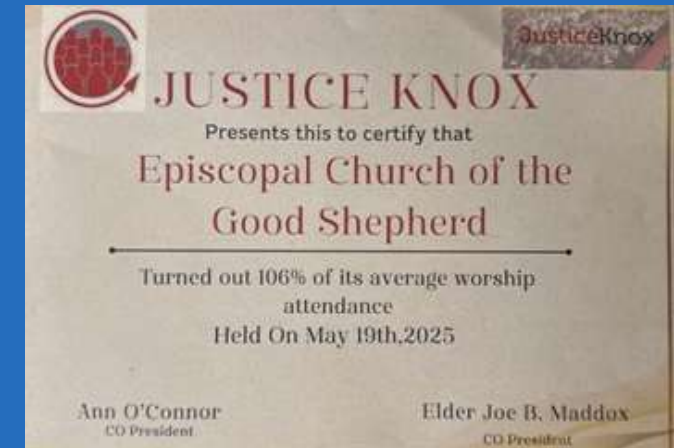

During his decades at Carson-Newman University, he invited students to explore the deep connections between psychology, peacemaking, and ecology, often leading them to Narrow Ridge Earth Literacy Center to learn directly from the land. As founder of The Emancipators—now Peaceabilities—his music has become a joyful expression of nonviolence and hope, shared at 100+ churches and gatherings across East Tennessee. Through his leadership at Narrow Ridge and steadfast involvement with OREPA, Justice Now, and other peace organizations, Guy-Larry embodies Earthkeeping as a means toward peace.
