Dear Teachers,

Thank you for incorporating art into your teaching and for encouraging your students to present their artwork at the Graham County Fair. Our objective for this department is to provide opportunities for young students in our community to learn how to create and display artwork as a class, with the hope that their experience will inspire them to make more art and enter it into the Fine Arts Departments, where they can earn premiums.

(Note: No premiums or fair entry tickets will be distributed to Classroom Art Entries.)

Before starting a project with your class, please read the rules in the document “**Classroom Art Entries Fair Book Page**” and follow them closely. Ignoring these rules will result in your entries being disqualified, meaning they will not be displayed, judged, or receive ribbons.

When your class has completed an art project for the fair, please:

1. **Register your class** (not individual students) under your name in Department Y as explained in the document “**How to Register Online.**”
Deadline: Sunday, September 21 at 11:59 p.m.
2. **Prepare student artwork** as defined in the document “**Instructions – Classroom Art Entries 2025.**”
3. **Submit entries on time:**
 - If your entries are not in the office by **Wednesday, September 24 at 3:00 p.m.**, you may bring them to the Parks Office on **Friday, September 26 at 9:00 a.m.**
 - **No entries will be accepted after 12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 26.**
4. **Retrieve entries after the fair:**
 - On the last day of the fair (**Sunday, October 12**), a designated person from your school must pick up your class entries between **5:00–7:00 p.m.**
