# PLENARY 4: HOMEOWNERSHIP REIMAGINED – INNOVATION, OPPORTUNITY AND THE AMERICAN DREAM

Homeownership is still central to the American Dream, but a one-size-fits-all, 30-year mortgage no longer fits today's realities—rising costs, multigenerational households, and nontraditional income.
