

How to Sign Up on the CardByte Mobile App (Android & iOS)

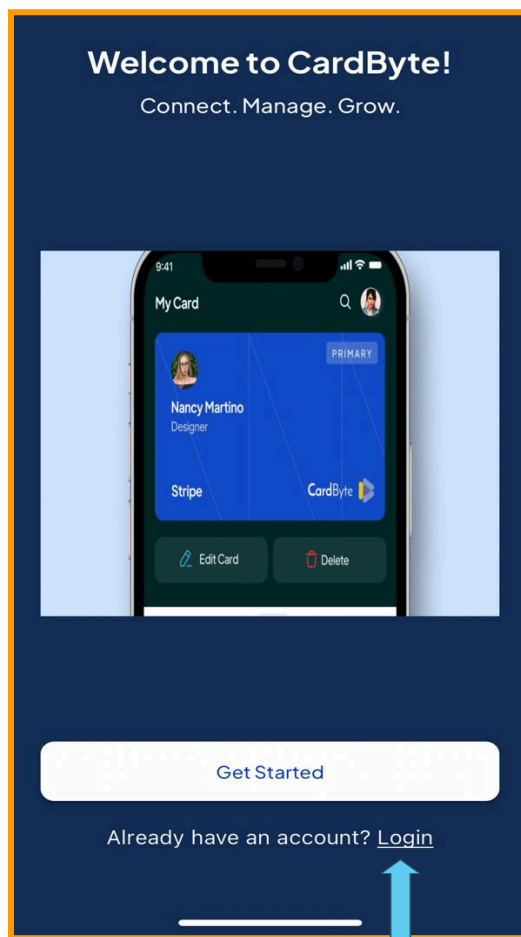
Follow these steps to create your CardByte account easily:

Download the CardByte App


- **Android Users:** [Download here](#).

Open the App:

- Once installed, **launch** the CardByte app.




- Set Up Your Password

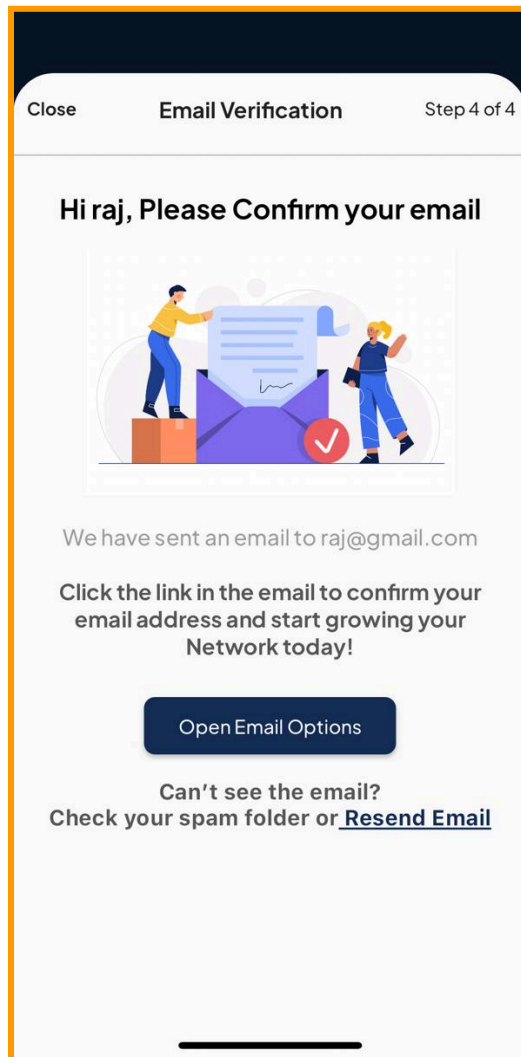


