

## How to Scan a CardByte QR Code from the Web App

You can easily scan and share digital business cards through the QR code feature. Here's how it works:


- Log in to the CardByte web app.

  - Click on the "Share" tab.






• A **pop-up window will appear**, displaying the QR code for your digital business card.




- Ask the recipient to open their phone's camera, Google Lens, or a QR scanner app.






- Log in to the CardByte mobile app.

- Alternatively, if you've added the CardByte widget to your phone's home screen, simply open the widget to reveal your QR code.




 Once they scan the QR code, a link will appear—they just need to tap it.
