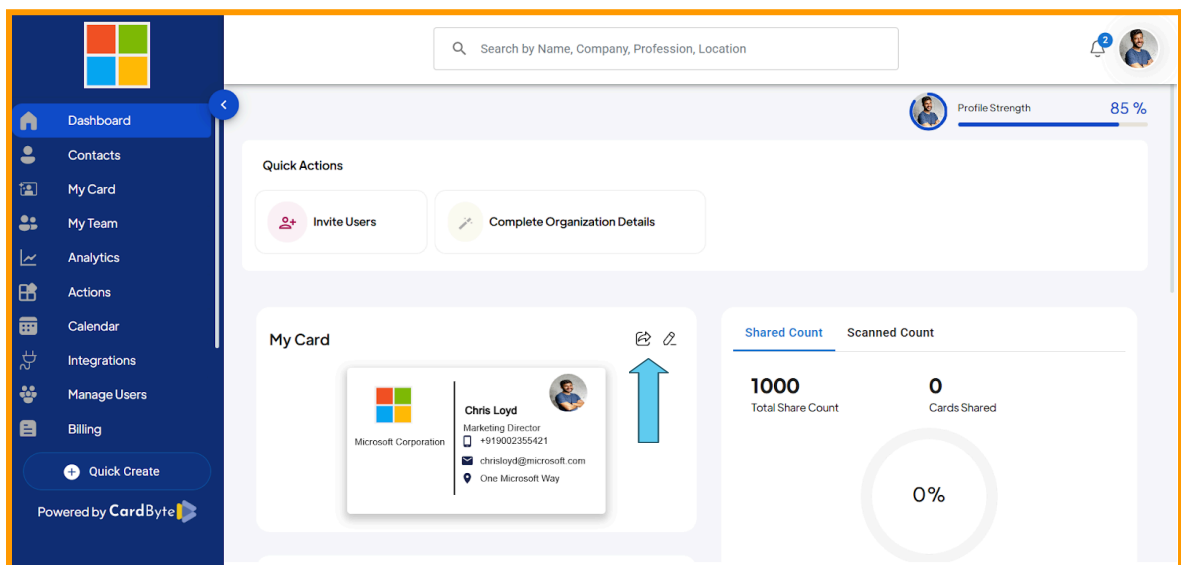


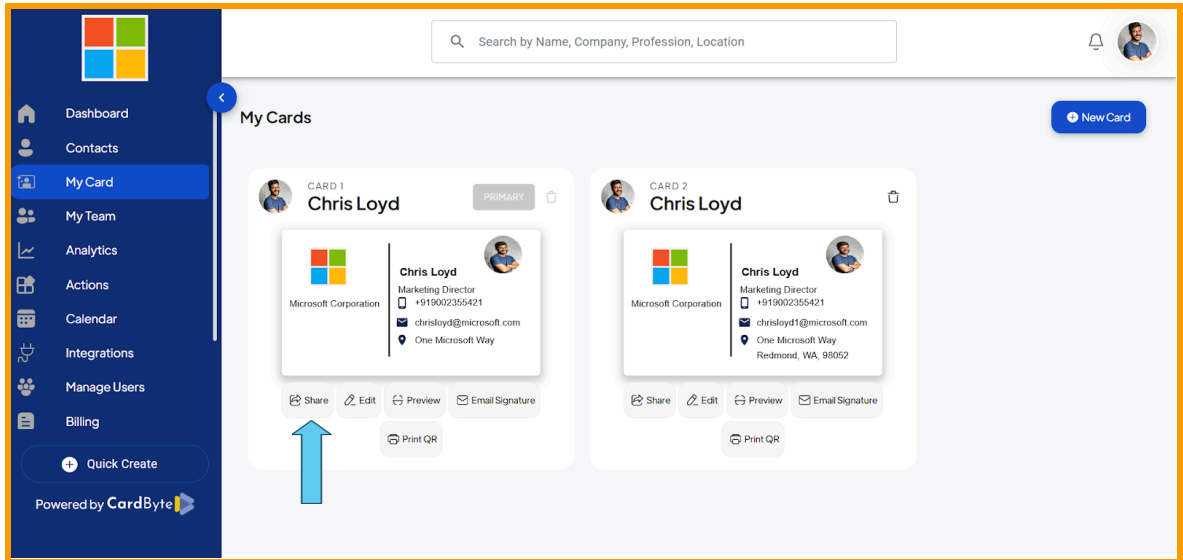
# How to Scan a CardByte QR Code from the Web App

You can easily scan and share digital business cards through the QR code feature. Here's how it works:

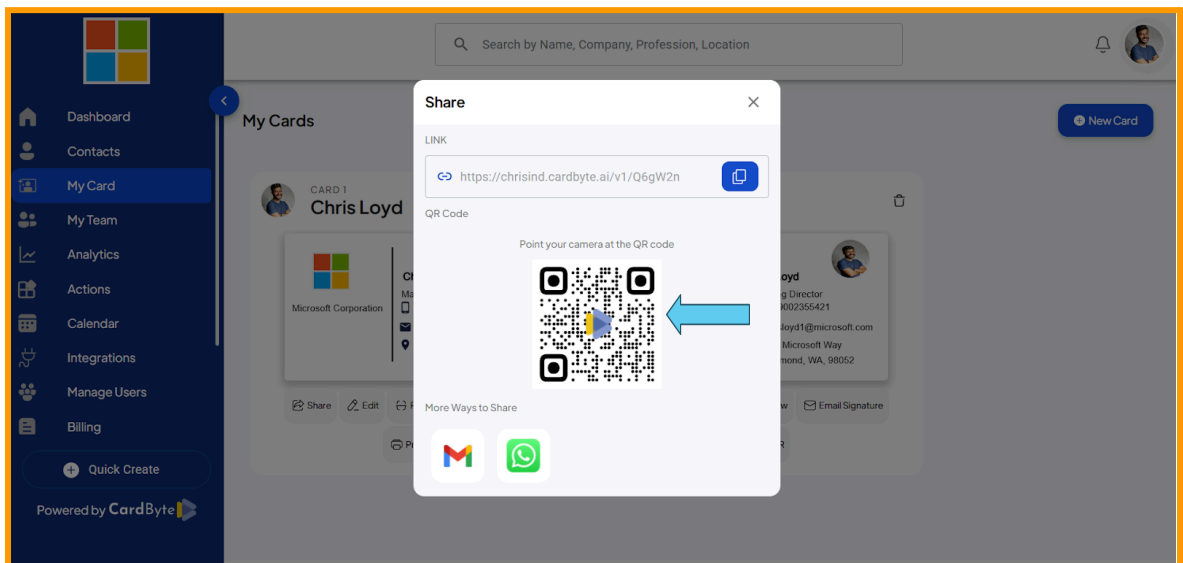
- **Log in** to the CardByte web app.

- Navigate to your card:
  - Click on the **“My Card”** tab, or
  - Use the **“Share Card”** option directly from the dashboard.
  - Click on the **“Share”** tab.



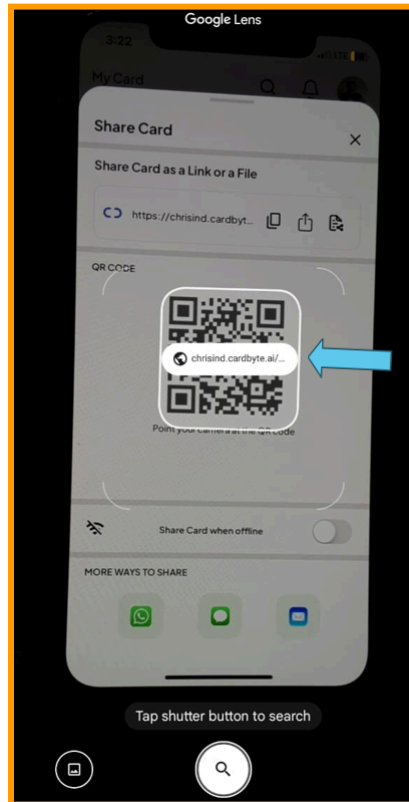

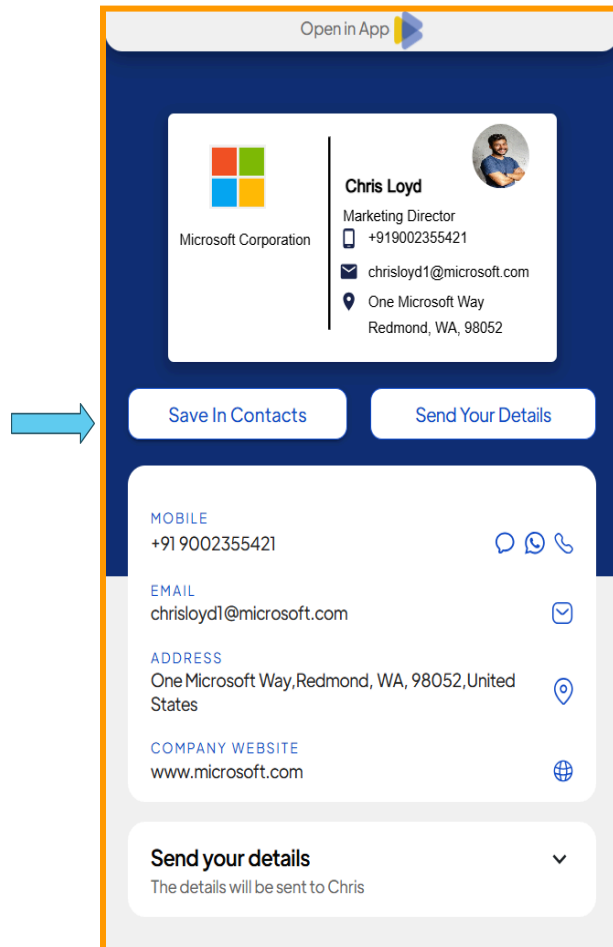
- A **pop-up window will appear**, displaying the QR code for your digital business card.



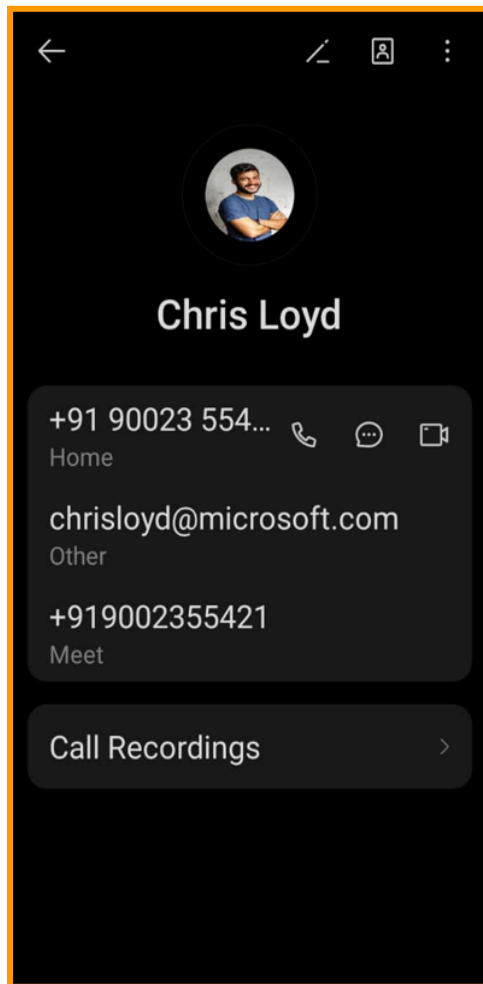
- Ask the recipient to **open their phone's camera, Google Lens, or a QR scanner app**.
- Once they **scan the QR code**, a link will pop up on their screen—ask them to tap the link.



- The link will open in their **browser**, displaying your digital business card.
- The recipient can then tap **“Save Contact”** to instantly store your details in their phonebook.



- Your Contact Information is now stored in the recipient's device and can be accessed as per their requirement.



The CardByte app is not required on the receiver's phone, making this a fast and seamless way to connect.

- Open the **CardByte Mobile App**.

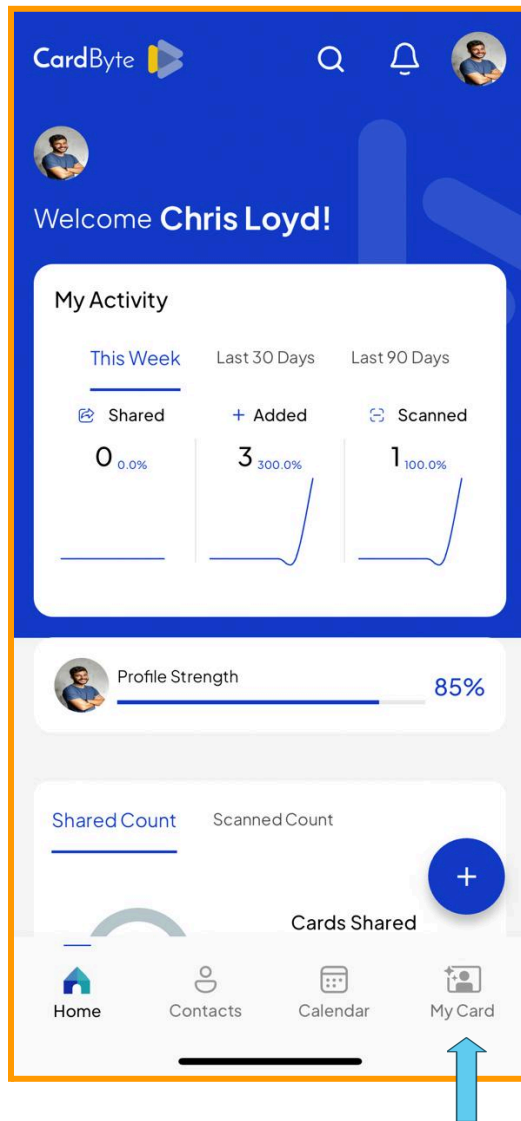

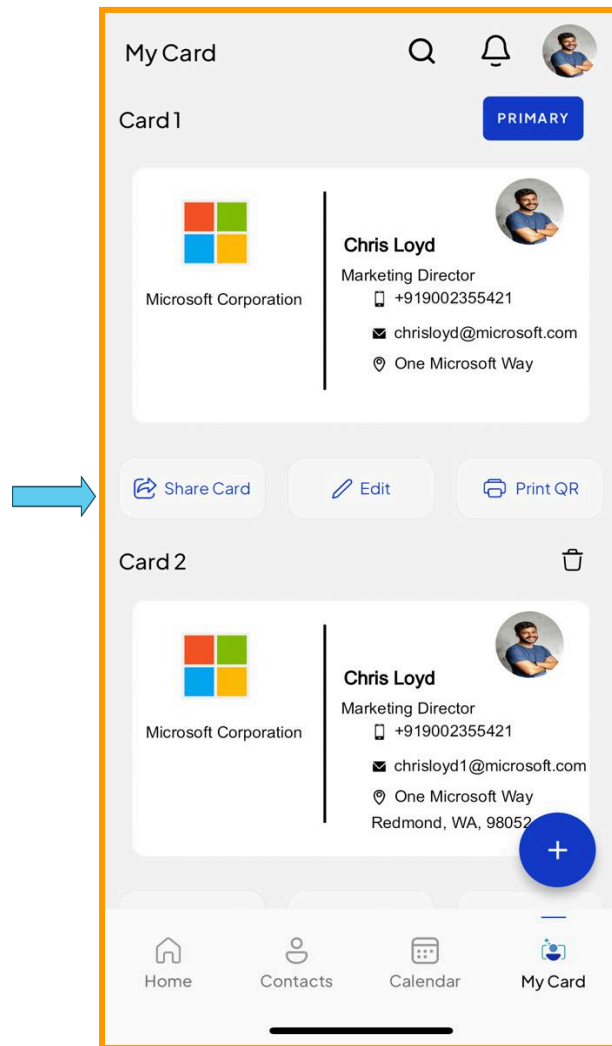

- Tap on the **“My Card”** tab.

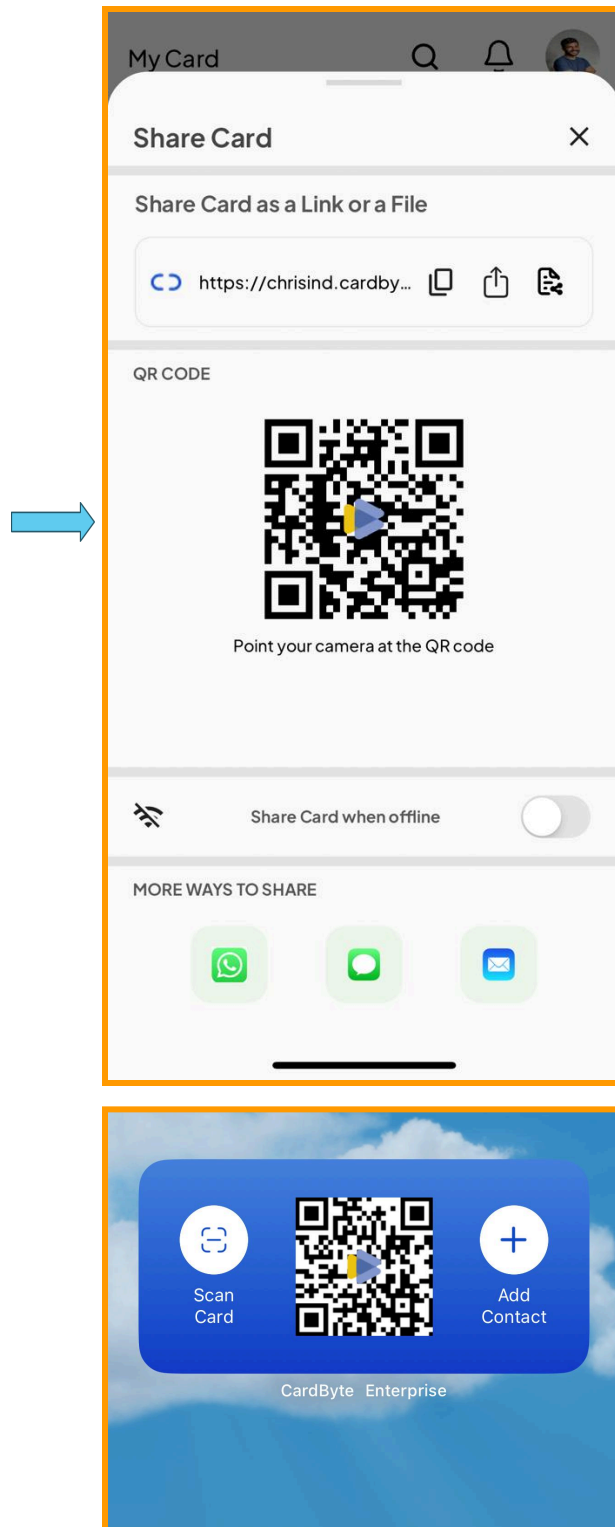


- Tap on the “**Share**” option of the card you want to share.



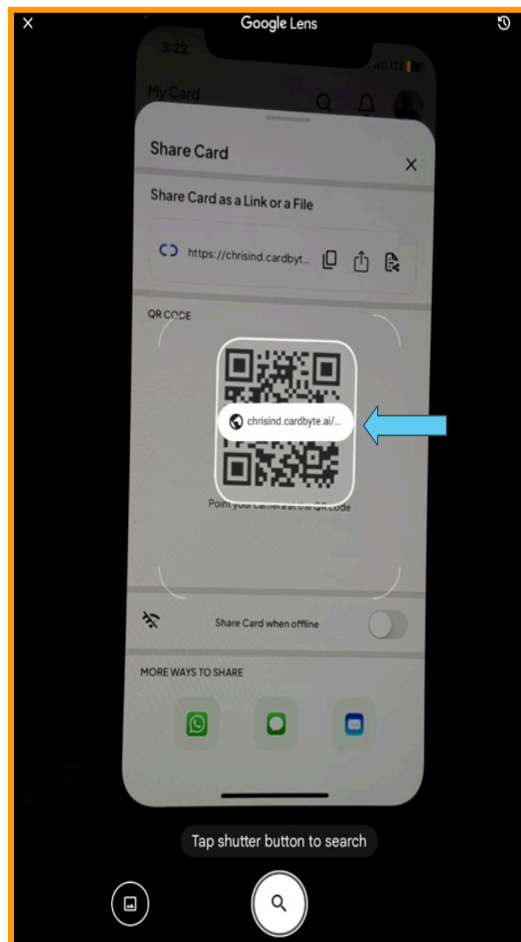
- A **pop-up screen will display your QR code** automatically
- Alternatively, if you've added the **CardByte widget** to your phone's home screen, simply open the widget to reveal your QR code.



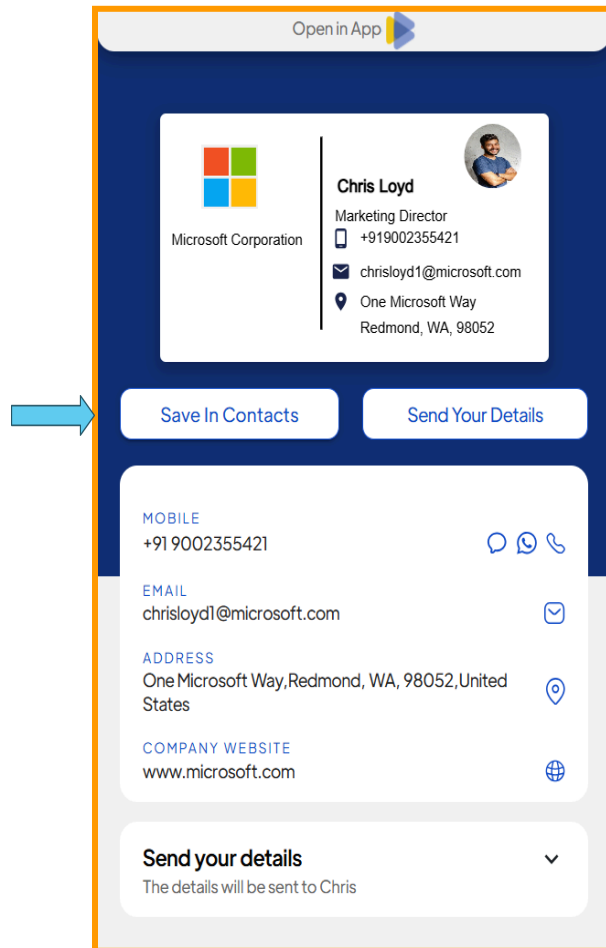


- Ask the recipient to **open their phone's camera, Google Lens,** or any **QR scanner app.**

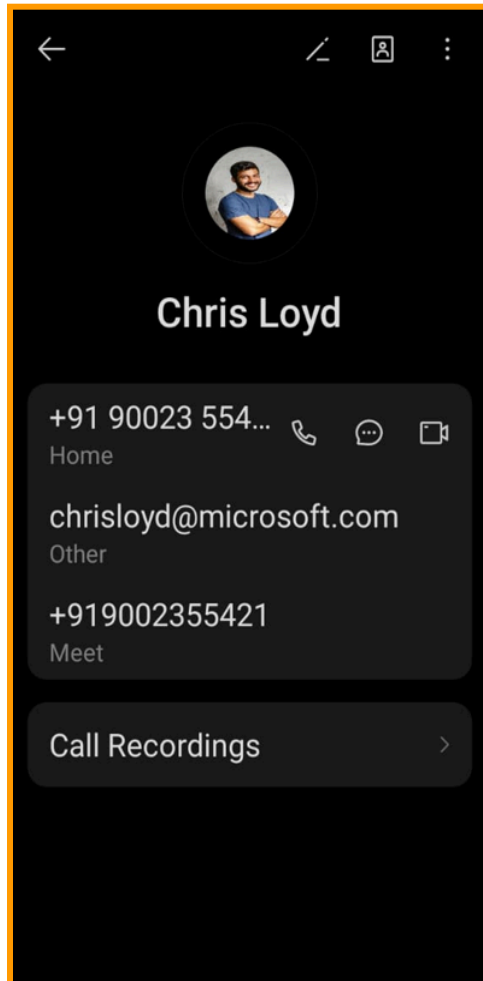
- Once they **scan the QR code**, a link will appear—they just need to tap it.
