

How to Scan a Paper Business Card Using the Camera in the CardByte Mobile App

Follow these steps to scan a paper business card directly using the CardByte app's scanner:

- Open the **CardByte Mobile App**.

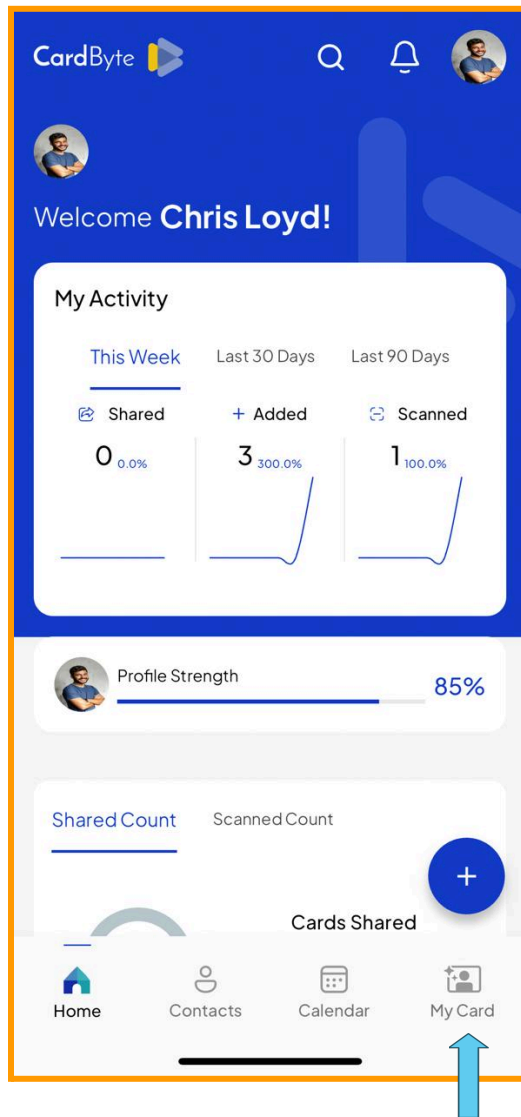

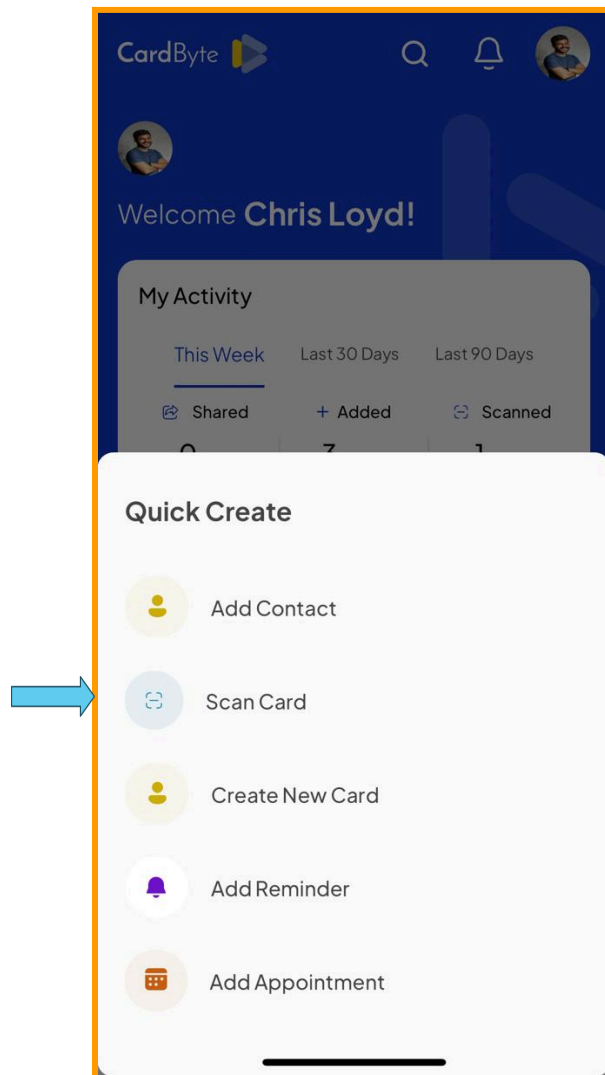

- **Log in** to the CardByte mobile app.
- **Go to "My Card"** by clicking on the nav bar.

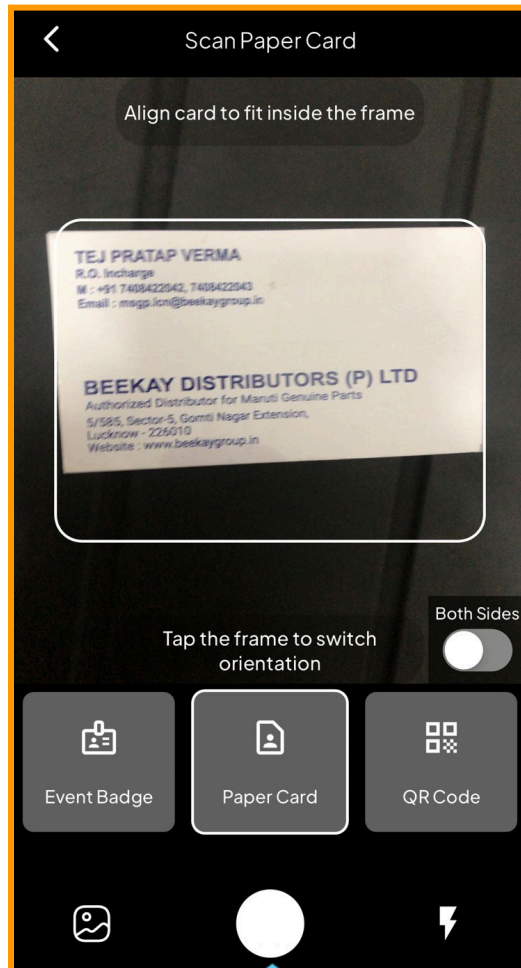


- Select the “**Scan Card**” option.




- On the next screen, choose between:
 - Scanning a physical card using your camera, or
 - Uploading a saved business card image from your **Gallery**.
 - (In this guide, we'll focus on **scanning with the camera**.)

- Place the **business card on a flat surface**, ensuring good lighting for clear visibility.
- Use the CardByte app's **scanner** to scan the business card.
- And click on the Circle icon.



- The app will automatically **extract contact details** from the card, including the card image. If needed, you can **edit or add extra details** before saving.



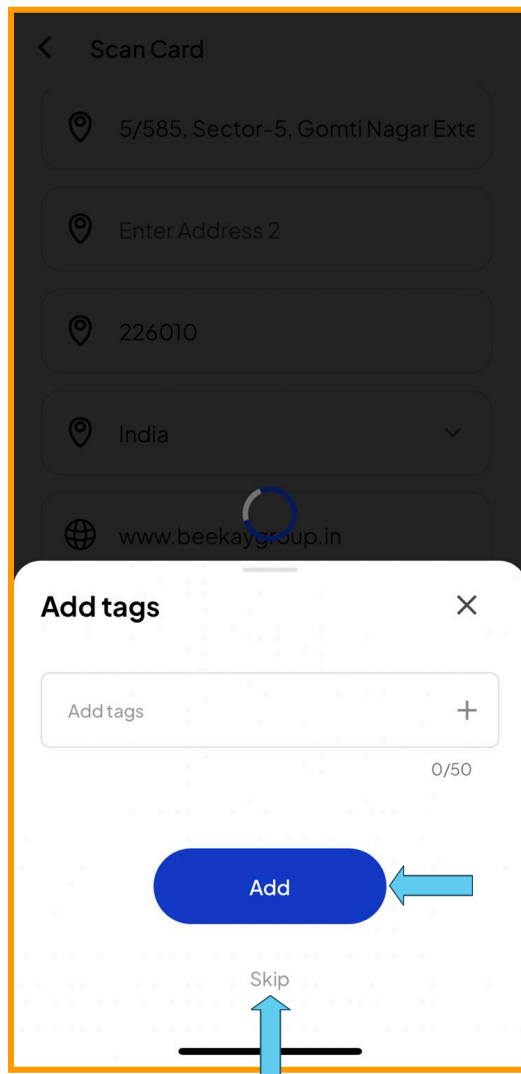
- Tap “**Save**” to store the contact.
