- Open the **CardByte** mobile app.

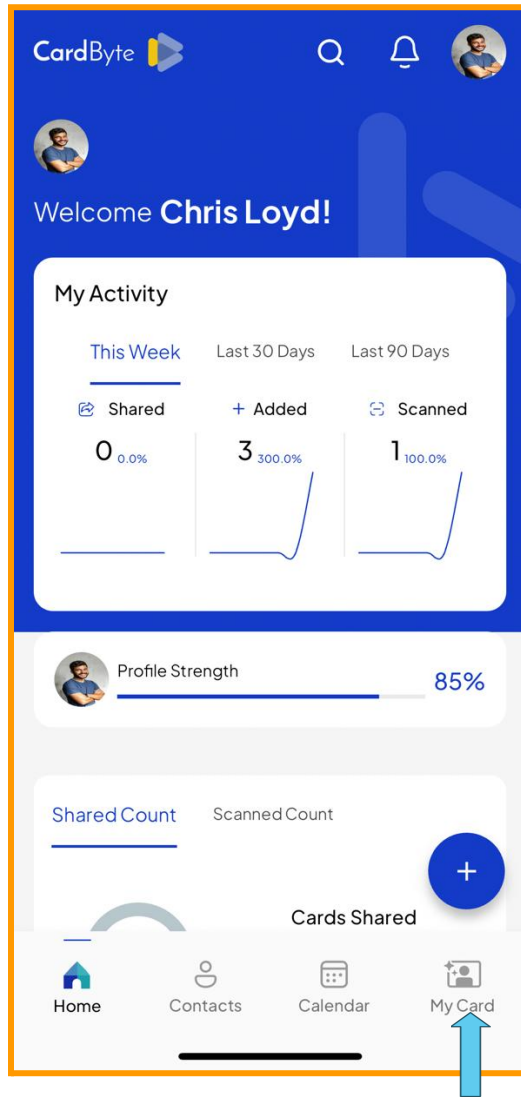

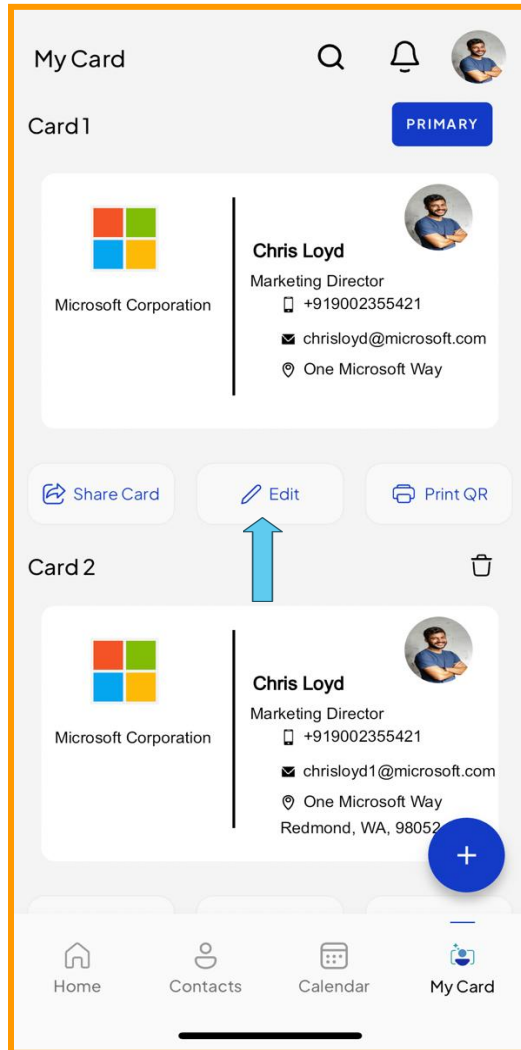

- Navigate to the My Card Tab on the Bottom Right



- Click on the **"Edit"** button to modify your details.



- You can update the following fields:
 - Profile Photo
 - Name
 - Contact Number
 - Designation
 - Address
 - Website URL
 - Social Media Handles
 - Business Summary

- If a field is locked and cannot be updated, then contact your admin to update the locked field.
