RESEARCH RESUME

HOT OFF THE PRESS

AI INNOVATION & PSYCHEDELIC NEUROSCIENCE <<<

Dr. Brian Ross successfully published "Leveraging psychedelic neuroscience to boost human <u>creativity using artificial intelligence</u>" in *Frontiers in Artificial Intelligence* as a sole author, in June. Three key points of research:

- Like psychedelics, AI may enhance creativity by disrupting habitual thought patterns
- Individualizing AI to personal traits may enhance creativity while supporting accessibility & equity
- Addressing bias, dependency, and creative homogenization is essential for positive outcomes

RURAL PERSPECTIVES ON AI & HEALTH EQUITY

Drs. Yifan Zhang, Sarah Newbery, David Savage, & Brian Ross successfully published their article "Artificial Intelligence and Rural Health Equity: Perspectives from Northern Ontario" in Journal of Rural and Community Development in September.

Three key points of research:

- Healthcare workers' concerns center on **infrastructure**, **resources**, and cultural & linguistic **inclusion**
- Optimism about Al's potential is tempered by concerns over its contextualization with local needs
- Early local community input is vital to effectively serve rural and underserved populations

ASSESSING LARGE LANGUAGE MODELS <<< (LLM) WITH USMLE QUESTIONS



Dr. Sabah Mohammed, Dr. Jinan Fiaidhi & their graduate student research team published a preprint of their article "Investigations on using Evidence-Based GraphRag Pipeline using LLM Tailored for USMLE Style Questions" in MedRxiv Health Science Server in May.

Three key points of research:

- Al achieved 83% accuracy on USMLE questions but were constrained by black-box limitations
- Adding an interface that links USMLE answers to medical evidence (Known as a "white-box" layer) increased accuracy to >90%
- The white-box interface integrates evidence-based reasoning with retrieval-augmented generation (I.e., GraphRAG)
