## **The Pantheon Showcases Agricultural Technology Driving Knox County's Future**

Vincennes, IN – On September 4, 2025, The Pantheon Business Incubator and Co-Working Space hosted the Agricultural Technology Showcase, highlighting Knox County as a hub for agricultural innovation and entrepreneurship. The event brought together Purdue University's Agriculture Leadership Program, local farmers, startup founders, and industry leaders to discuss how collaboration is shaping the county's agricultural future. One of the highlights of the showcase was TerraForce, a robotics startup founded by Mike Jacob and launched at The Pantheon. With more than 90% of its early investment coming from Knox County, TerraForce demonstrates how local entrepreneurs and community partners are creating solutions with regional, statewide, and national impact. "It is great to be a part of a community that is actively creating its own future," said Mike Jacob, Founder & CEO of TerraForce. "TerraForce will not only make American farmers competitive and generate meaningful local economic outcomes, it will also give our best, brightest, and most curious minds a path to return home and contribute to the community that invested so heavily in them."

The panel discussions emphasized the importance of partnerships, workforce development, and creating an ecosystem where farmers and entrepreneurs can thrive.
