Showjumping Competitions

Stabling:

- Stabling contractors - Cheval Starbox Ltd.
- Exhibitors requiring horse stabling must notify their requirements on or before Sunday 3 May.
- Showjumping exhibitors can book stabling at a cost of £46.00 per stable, per night, to include straw or £120.00 per stable for all three nights, to include straw for each night.
- The horse stables are available for the following times:
Wednesday night bookings: 8am Wednesday until 6pm on the Thursday
Thursday night bookings: 6pm on the Thursday until 6pm on the Friday
Friday night bookings: 6pm on the Friday until classes have finished on the Saturday
- Stabling will only be available on the night before / day of showing. All exhibitors must vacate stables by 6.00pm unless they have reserved the stable for other nights.
- If stables are oversubscribed the Association reserves the right to restrict the booking of stables for those exhibitors only showing on one day.
- Please note that stables are NON-TRANSFERABLE.

General Rulings:

- The Association reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in any class.
- All classes require competitors to declare, and will be drawn order, the drawn order will be published on the R.C.A.A. website on the Tuesday morning of the show week.
- Entries in classes A - H are restricted to horses and ponies registered with British Showjumping and ridden by members in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79.
- All competitors must wear uniform or hunting costume or appropriate hats and coats. Failure to comply may involve elimination.
- All competitors must wear a protective helmet manufactured to the current approved BSI or European Standard. Such headgear must be worn with the chin strap correctly and securely fastened at all times.
- The use of helmet mounted cameras at British Showjumping Events is not allowed.
- No horse may be exercised other than in a collecting ring.
- No horse should be left unattended other than when securely contained within a horse vehicle or stable.
- No member shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any showjumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- During jumping competitions, three competitors must always be ready to enter the ring. If a competitor does not respond when their 'Order Number' is called, they lose their turn and the horse bearing the number called may be eliminated.
- There will be a time limit for all jumping competitions. The time limit for each competition will be announced before the competition starts.
- Automatic timing apparatus will be in operation.
- Prize giving in all classes will be mandatory "Mounted" in accordance with rule 101.7.

First Day - Thursday 4 June

Class A: The Grade 'C' Jumping Competition

Under Table A7, Speed 350 metres per minute.

Start height 1.25m

For registered Grade 'C' horses only, to be ridden by adult, associate or junior members, who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

E116 A Perpetual Challenge Trophy, given in memory of Elizabeth Ingram, by her family for the highest placed rider in Class A, resident in Cornwall. Previous winner: Miss M Juleff.

The total prize money for this class will be £750 (£250, £175, £125, £60, £50, £40, £30, £20).

Class B: The Cornish Open incorporating Senior 1.35m Open

Under Table A9, speed 375 metres per minute.

Start height 1.35m

For registered horses in Grades: A, B and C. Ridden by adult, associate or junior members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

The total prize money for this class will be £2,000 (£650, £475, £325, £200, £150, £100, £50, £50).

Class C: National 1.30m Open

Rule 306, under Table A4, speed 350 metres per minute.

Start height 1.30m

For registered horses in Grades: A, B and C. Ridden by adult, associate or junior members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

The total prize money for this class will be £1,250 (£360, £250, £200, £150, £100, £80, £60, £50).

Second Day - Friday 5 June

Class D: Area Trial

Under Table A9. Two round competition speed 375 metres per minute

Start height 1.50m

To be judged under Rule 293.

For registered horses in Grades 'A' and 'B', to be ridden by adult, associate or junior members. Competitors may not compete in classes on horses with a starting height in the first round that exceeds 1.40m, until the year in which they reach their 16th Birthday.

The total prize money for this class will be £3,000 (£1000, £750, £550, £300, £175, £100, £75, £50).

Class E: The Open Accumulator

Starting height 1.30m. Speed 375 metres per minute. Joker fence will be a maximum height of 1.45m.

To be judged under Rule 274 of the 2026 Rule Book.

The total prize money for this class will be £1,250 (£400, £300, £200, £150, £80, £50, £40, £30).

Class F: Royal Cornwall Mini Major

By invitation only. No Entry Fee.

8 Juniors and 8 Seniors will compete.

Rescue Relay Format, Juniors will go first.

They will jump a maximum of 1m and will be invited via qualification having competed at local Cornish shows.

The Seniors will jump 1.15m/1.20m approx. and will be nominated on the day.

E117 A Silver Cup for the Junior Winner of Class 'F'. Previous winner: Isabella Bonney.

The total prize money for this class will be £700 (£230, £150, £100, £80, £50, £40, £30, £20).

Third Day - Saturday 6 June

Class G: The National 1.30m Open

Under Table A7. Speed 375 metres per minute.

Start height 1.30m

To be judged under Rule 306 - Two double clears qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships.

For registered horses, to be ridden by adult, associate or junior members. Competitors may not compete in classes on horses with a starting height in the first round that exceeds 1.30m, until the year in which they reach their 14th Birthday.

The total prize money for this class will be £1,250 (£340, £250, £200, £150, £100, £80, £70, £60).

Class H: Grand Prix

Under Table A9. Two Round Competition Speed 375 metres per minute.

Start height 1.40m

To be judged under Rule 301.

For registered Grade A and B horses, to be ridden by adult, associate or junior members. Competitors may not compete in classes on horses with a starting height in the first round that exceeds 1.40m, until the year in which they reach their 16th Birthday.
