Cattle Section

BVD Testing:

All cattle attending the 2026 Royal Cornwall Show **MUST** reside in a herd which has been tested as part of a recognised BVD eradication programme or to have been individually tested for BVD antigen with a negative result. Individual BVD antigen results may be obtained via blood sampling or tissue tagging. For those cattle keepers using herd status to demonstrate BVD freedom, antibody results must not be older than 12 months before the date of arrival at the show.

Please send with your entry form proof of testing and negative status (CHECS BVD certificate or individual animal test result sheet).

Beef Young Handler Classes:

Please note that for classes 316 and 317, bull calves are to be born on or after 1 October 2025, not the date printed in the schedule.

Sheep Section

The 2026 Royal Cornwall Show will not see the running of the Wool on the Hoof classes due to changes with how British Wool are operating at shows this season however, this has created an opportunity for us to stage a brand new Inter-Breed Championship. The winner of each breed group class will be eligible to come forward and compete in the Group of Three Championship, to be judged on Friday morning ahead of the other inter-breed championships and by a separate judge which for 2026 will be Mr A Wear from Somerset.
