VEHICLE DEPOSIT SYSTEM

Exhibitors' vehicles entering on Show days for the purpose of taking authorised persons or goods to any stand will be required to pay a:

**DEPOSIT OF £75.00 FOR THE VEHICLE AND £22.50 FOR EACH PERSON NOT IN
POSSESSION OF A TICKET.**

From **6.30am**. A deposit will be taken using a credit/debit card at the Machinery Entrance **is it Trade / Livestock**, a hold will be put on the deposit in your account, and a receipt given. When this receipt is produced at the Trade exit **before 9am on the same day**, the deposit money will be released back to your account.

RULES

- 1.All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.**
- 2.Under RPRA Rules, all pigeons must be vaccinated against the paramyxovirus.**
- 3.Judging will commence at 9.30am on the first day of the Show, birds not penned by 9.00am will be too late for judging; entries for One Day Show may be penned from 6.00pm on Friday evening or Saturday morning up to 9.00am.
- 4.No exhibit shall be removed from its pen after judging has been completed except in an emergency.
- 5.Pens may be wired when judging is completed.
- 6.EXHIBITS FOR THE TWO-DAY SHOW WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO BE REMOVED FROM THE PENS UNTIL 5.30pm ON THE SECOND DAY AND EXHIBITS FOR THE ONE DAY SHOW WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO BE REMOVED FROM THE PENS UNTIL THE PIGEON SECTION CLOSURES AT 5.00pm ENTRIES ARE ONLY ACCEPTED ON THIS UNDERSTANDING
- 7.Exhibits may only be penned and unpenned in the presence of a steward.
- 8.Pigeons entered in both Shows must be sent with both class and pen numbers on basket compartment; exhibits for One Day Show to be entered on the One Day entry form.
- 9.Any protest must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £5 delivered to the Secretary before 2.00pm on the day of judging.
- 10.All exhibitors/entrants are advised to cleanse and disinfect the show pens, crates or baskets before the event and to cleanse and disinfect on return to the home premises and before they are used to hold any other bird.
- 11.Every reasonable care will be taken of exhibits, but the committee cannot be held responsible for accidents, injuries, losses, or deaths however caused. All exhibits will be penned and fed by experienced stewards. No unauthorised person will be allowed to handle any exhibit during the time the show is open.**
- 12. Please be aware that we are subject to change at any time from DEFRA/APHA on rules of the showing/gathering of pigeons.**

Privacy Policy

The Royal Cornwall Agricultural Association privacy policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, that you provide to us or that we may receive from others about you will be processed by us. It includes data that we hold electronically and in paper files.

Information relating to Exhibitors and their animals / exhibits may be provided to Department of Environment, Fisheries and Rural Affairs (DEFRA), Trading Standards, Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA), British Cattle Movement Service (BCMS), SAC, Breed Societies, County Councils, Veterinary Advisors and others who have regulatory access.
