Speak AAC to teach AAC! Modeling without expectations means that we use the communication device or communication board when speaking to the user without requiring that they respond. We use the device to supplement what we are saying while touching key words while talking. The purpose of this is to demonstrate or "model" how to use the device in a natural context. Combine more words based on the user's communication level.

Example: Say: "We need to water the plant." Level 1: model NEED, Level 2: model WE+NEED, Level 3: model WE+NEED+WATER, Level 4: WE+NEED+WATER+IT
