## AAC Essentials: What Every Communication Partner Needs to Know

This interactive learning experience explores innovative, evidence-informed approaches to supporting language acquisition for students of all ages and communication profiles. By creating enriched communication environments, participants will learn how to increase meaningful language opportunities within everyday routines while honoring diverse language learning pathways, including gestalt language processing.

Participants will gain practical insights into current best practices for augmentative and alternative communication (AAC), including supporting language development, selecting robust and functional vocabulary, and fostering sustained engagement among AAC users. The session will also address advanced-level topics related to AAC assessment and implementation, with strategies for identifying and reducing common barriers through a coaching-centered model.

In addition, the presentation will introduce the thoughtful integration of AI-supported tools—such as ChatGPT—to help streamline therapy planning, generate reflective prompts, support documentation, and improve efficiency without replacing clinical judgment. These tools will be taught as supports for enhancing decision-making, tracking progress, and improving outcomes for AAC users.

The session will emphasize building the skills and confidence of communication partners and demonstrate how coaching-based training can empower parents, educators, and support staff to promote consistent AAC use across environments. Through collaborative practices, emerging technology, and a strengths-based lens, participants will leave with actionable strategies to support meaningful, lifelong communication growth.
