The performance takes place at Marriott Theatre in Lincolnshire, IL. The theatre is part of a hotel called the Lincolnshire Marriott Resort. Look for the large, light-up Marriott Theatre marquee outside the building and enter through the glass doors below.

The theatre lobby has two interweaving staircases and one elevator that take you up to the theatre doors. There you will find our ushers, who may assist you in finding your seat.

Be sure to arrive at least 15-20 minutes before the performance starts to get seated and take in the scenery!

Marriott Theatre is seated in-the-round, where the audience surrounds the stage. There are four aisles going to and from the stage and two main exits.

There are also couches outside of the theatre doors where you may sit if you need a break from the performance.



some Things Some to Consider

ABOUT THE SHOW

Finding Nemo is a colorful, musical adventure under the sea! The show runs about 1 hour, followed by a Question & Answer session with the cast after every performance.

LIGHT AND SOUND

There is a large ring-shaped video screen in the center of the theatre and four light-up walls behind each section of the audience. There will be bright, colorful lighting and flashing lights during the show. It will also get very dark. Music will be played and characters will sing throughout the show, which may become loud or exciting at times.

ACTORS AND MOVEMENT

Performers will enter and exit with their puppets through the aisles, moving close to audience members seated near the ends of rows.

MAGICAL MOMENTS


Expect to see bubbles, extra-large scuba gear, and fun sea creatures brought to life by the actors and their puppets!

BIG FEELINGS AND STORY CONSIDERATIONS

The show includes some intense and emotional moments. Early in the story, a character dies, and there are scenes where Nemo and Marlin face danger or feel scared and worried. There are also a few slightly scary creatures, like sharks and deep-sea animals— but everything turns out okay in the end! The story is full of love, courage, and family, showing how we can learn to trust and care for each other.


FOR YOUR SAFETY

Prologue

LOCATION: THE REEF "PROLOGUE"

The lights get darker signaling that it's time to start the show!


The video screens light-up and actors holding puppets enter the stage, bringing the sea to life.

Coral and Marlin are happy to find their new home.

When you see the red clownfish eggs, that's the signal that a scary moment is about to occur...

A Barracuda enters the stage and a character dies offstage. Marlin and Coral lose their eggs to the Barracuda, but one egg remains safe: Nemo!

Scary sounds, flashing lights, and sad music play during this sequence.


Music plays and lights/video screens go dark as the scene changes.*

Happy, excited energy as Nemo gets ready for his very first day of school!

Marlin is anxious about Nemo starting school.

Sea creatures of all kinds fill the stage and video screens in a whirl of color and sing excitedly!

Marlin realizes that Nemo is going to an unsafe area and swims worriedly after him.





*This happens after every scene!

Scene 2

LOCATION: THE DROP-OFF

"THE DROP-OFF"

"THE BOAT

"ABDUCTION/BIG BLUE WORLD (REPRISE)"

"DORY'S DITTY"

"SHARK TERRITORY"

"FISH ARE FRIENDS, NOT FOOD" The ocean grows darker.

When you hear the words "touch the BUTT!", that's the signal that a couple of emotional and scary moments are about to occur...

Nemo and Marlin argue and say very mean words.

Nemo is captured in a diver's net and taken away from Marlin! Everyone is scared and swims away. The lights and music become frantic.

Marlin meets a new friend named Dory and everything feels better.





When Dory says, "You're a clownfish!", that's the signal that Bruce and his Shark Mates are entering the stage (these sharks are more silly than scary!).


Dory accidentally gets a nosebleed, and the Sharks pick up on the scent! The lights and screens turn a slightly-scary red.

Nemo is in a strange, new place and feels scared.

Scene 4

Look for the scuba mask that floats back onstage: it might hold a clue to where Nemo is!

Marlin is anxious and becomes mad with Dory.

Some jellyfish enter the stage and the lights get darker. Watch out for their tentacles!

Dory is in trouble for a moment, but Marlin rescues her. They reconcile, and continue their search for Nemo.



Scene 5

LOCATION: THE SYDNEY
HARBOUR AQUARIUM
"MORNING IN THE TANK"
"It's Go Time!"
"Not My Dad"

The aquarium tank is dirty and green!

Nemo finds out Marlin is searching for him and feels surprised and unsure.

Nigel the Seagull talks to the audience. If he asks a question, answer nice and loud!



Did You?

The Great Barrier Reef (where Nemo and Marlin live) is SO big that you can see it from outer space . . . It's larger than the entire country of Italy!

"GO WITH THE FLOW"



Little Squirt the Sea Turtle escapes a powerful current all by himself.

The Sea Turtles send Dory and Marlin on a totally awesome ride through the EAC!



Scene 7

LOCATION: OPEN OCEAN & THE SYDNEY HARBOUR AQUARIUM

"One Dedicated Father"

"THAT'S MY DAD"

"No Time to Waste"

"We SWIM TOGETHER (REPRISE)"

"NEMO ESCAPES"

Some Dolphins hear about Marlin's adventures and news travels back to Nemo. Be sure to listen to the entire story the Dolphins tell!

Marlin and Dory get trapped in a whale's mouth for a brief moment, but don't worry! Dory has a special talent that sets them free.

Now knowing his dad is a hero, Nemo bravely escapes the tank all by himself.

Sea creatures "talking" might sound silly, but scientists have recorded dolphins, whales, and even some fish communicating through sound!




Marlin and Dory find Nemo!

The actors bow to signal that the show is over and we all clap our hands and cheer!




Be sure to stick around after the performance for a brief Question & Answer session with the whole cast!
