DIRECTOR'S NOTE

"Oh, there's no place like home for the holidays..."

Presley, Johnny Cash, Carl Perkins, and Jerry Lee Lewis all came up together under the roof and guidance of Sam Phillips at Sun Records is integral to their origin stories. The four will be forever linked not only by the fateful night they spent jamming together at 706 Union Avenue in Memphis on December 4, 1956, but also by their shared journey from poverty to stardom — and all the highs and lows in-between. It was a brotherhood they deeply understood and recognized in one another, as complex and real as any biological family, with Sun Records serving as as much of a home as any of them had known.

While the quartet (and Elvis' then-girlfriend, Marilyn — here called Dyanne) didn't sing holiday songs that night, each of these artists went on to release beloved Christmas music of their own and the relationships and stories at the heart of this imagined "what-if" sequel are very much rooted in truth and deeply researched. In shaping this holiday reimagining of *Million Dollar Quartet*, we asked ourselves: what more could we say that the original didn't? The holidays, which for many are a time of joy, are also a moment to pause and reflect—on where we've been, where we are, and where we're going. This evening at Sun Records is no different. Families gather. Traditions are formed. Grievances are aired. Songs are sung. Memories are made. And when the holidays are over, we go our separate ways — hopefully with a new perspective. With that in mind, the holiday theme offers the opportunity to further explore the family dynamics (both biological and found) at the heart of their stories

Million Dollar Quartet Christmas couldn't have happened without the wonderful family of collaborators who poured their hearts and talents into bringing this show to life. However you celebrate, I hope this musical brings you even a fraction of the joy it gave us in creating it.
