The Esplanade Closure – What You Can Do

The Esplanade connects Surfers Paradise. Closing it has divided the precinct and crippled access for residents, visitors and businesses alike. The already fragile road network can't cope, and yet reports claim the trial is a "success."

But we can respond – and it only takes a few minutes.

1 Call Council to register your concern

Every call is logged independently of the project. These calls count and they are noticed. Even a two-minute call makes a difference. **1300 465 326 (1300 GOLD COAST)**

2 Take our short 6-question survey

A small action, but powerful if many of us do it. The results will give us real data to show the impact this closure is having on local business.
