Position Announcement: Public Education Coordinator

The Gault School of Archaeological Research (GSAR) is a IRS-certified 501(c)3 non-profit organization whose primary mission is to help preserve and promote the Gault Archaeological Site, located near Florence, Texas approximately one hour north of Austin. GSAR has three program pillars: Education, Research, and Conservation. Our efforts in each of these areas share the goal of enriching our communities through different forms of educational outreach, promoting site and land conservation, and developing a better understanding of, and appreciation for, the past.

With support from the Summerlee Foundation, we are looking to fill the position of Education Program Coordinator, and anticipate being able to offer at least two years of employment starting in early 2026. The right candidate will have strong experience in fields like heritage resource management, public education, and/or archaeology or public history. We seek a well-organized, motivated individual who is capable of taking initiative, working alone and collaboratively with our Board of Directors, and who can help us build and develop programs targeting both K-12 and adult learners.

We foresee that this individual will work with statewide educational associations to help improve the status of social studies and history in public education curriculum standards; develop partnerships with nearby and regional Independent School Districts to support teachers in motivating hands-on education and learning outcomes; and contribute to our ongoing site tours programs. We would welcome the ability to track engagement in our educational program and increase its impact and effectiveness over time through use of constituent databases or other means. Experience with grant writing and public speaking are important.

It is important that GSAR finds the right individual for this opportunity. Depending on the circumstances, we are prepared to offer a full-time, salaried position with benefits, or to work flexibly with the ideal candidate on a part-time basis.
