Computing-coding

An occurrence that causes a block of code to be run. The event could be the result of user action such

as the user pressing a key (when Key) or clicking or swiping the screen (when Clicked, when Swiped) or when objects interact (collision). In 2Code, the ent commands are used to create blocks of code that are run when events happen.

When coding commands are put inside other commands. These commands. These commands only run when the outer command runs.

In this context, this is any object or situation that can be analysed and modelled. For example modelling the function of a traffic light, modelling friction of cars moving down surfaces or modelling the functions of a home's security system.

A block or sequence of code that you can access when you need it, so you don't have to rewrite the code repeatedly. Instead, you simply 'call' the function each time you

want it.

Items in a program that can be given instructions to move or change in some way (action). In 2Code Gorilla, the **object types** are button number, input, text, shape turtle, character, object, vehicle, animal.

These determine the look

and size of an object. Each object has properties such as the image, scale and position of the object.

A conditional decision command. When selection is used, a program will choose which bit of code to run depending on a condition. In 2Code selection is accomplished using 'if' or 'if/else'

Information going into the computer. This could be the user moving or clicking the mouse, or the user entering characters on the keyboard. On tablets there are other forms such as finger swipes, touch gestures and tilting the
