### Year 1

## The Mini Muslim

During **Story Hour**, we will relive the powerful stories of the **Companions**: why **Zayd (ra)** chose to stay with the Prophet (s) instead of returning to his father, why the Prophet (s) entrusted **Abdullah ibn Umm Maktum (ra)** with leadership in Madinah despite his blindness, and how **Asma (ra)** earned the title *'Owner of Two Belts'* through her courage and sacrifice.

During Story Hour, we will discover the paths tread by the great **Tabi'een** and draw powerful lessons from their lives, including **Uways al Qarni (rh)**, **Hasan al Basri (rh)** and **Umar ibn Abdal Aziz (rh)**.
