What Are Hard Skills?

Hard skills are **teachable abilities** like coding, marketing, design, and data analysis. They're easy to prove and crucial for getting past AI screeners.

Where to Show Off Your Skills on Your Resume

- Resume Summary (Top Section): Mention 1–2 top hard skills + 1 important soft skill that matches the job.
- Skills Section (Near the Top or Side Column): Create a clean list of hard and soft skills, focusing on keywords from the job description.
- **Experience Section**: Show how you used both hard and soft skills in your past roles with real examples and numbers.
- Certifications Section (If you have it): List important certifications that prove your hard skills.
- Pro Tip: If you're in tech, add a "Technical Skills" section just for your hard skills (like programming languages, tools, platforms)!

✓	Use Exact Keywords Mirror the job description — no guessing!	\Diamond	Being too vague ("good with computers")
~	Be Specific, Not General "SQL Data Analysis" beats "good with numbers."		Skipping keywords from the job posting
~	Show Proof Back up your skills with real results and projects.		Listing skills that aren't relevant
✓	Highlight Both Skill Types Show your technical chops and your people skills.	✓	Stay focused. Stay real.
