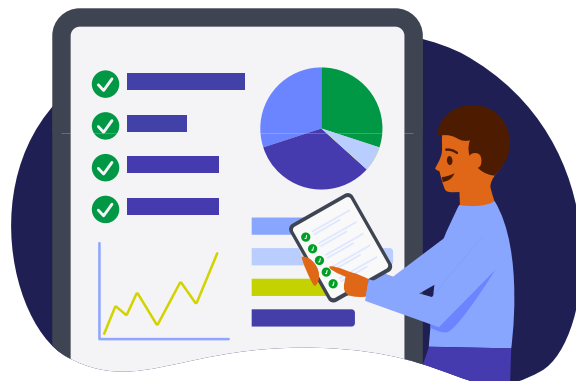


Are you ready for a surprise audit?
