Three lucky families were recently chosen to take part in the Wetwheels Pirate Day at Eastbourne Sovereign Harbour.



The Tugwell Park Fun Day is back for 2025 on the 2nd August! There will be lots of music, activities and fun to be had so head down for a fantastic afternoon.




Patcham Duck Fayre 🦫
