We want to support them in any way we can with the work they do. Often, the children they visit at home are due blood tests, chemotherapy or other medication that involves needles and, of course, a degree of pain, discomfort or fear. Being able to offer the child a little toy or gift at the end of the visit gives them some positive encouragement and means that the visit ends with happiness, rather than tears.


