

### **About the Initiative**

Each year, hundreds of students previously enrolled in Metro Nashville Public Schools do not re-enroll in the new school year and are removed from rosters after 10 days.

### Alignment Nashville's Attendance A-Team

identified this reality as an opportunity to re-align and activate existing community resources to help resolve the problem. As a result, the A-Team developed the **Project Reconnect Initiative** to identify, train, and mobilize community partners to assist in locating and re-engaging those MNPS students.

In July 2021, the A-Team launched an Invitation to Participate for organizations to join the initiative.

The criteria to participate required that community organizations have the capacity to:

- Send staff to Project Reconnect training
- Make efforts to find families and caregivers of students who are not re-enrolled
- Assist families and caregivers in getting students re-enrolled in MNPS
- Help families identify barriers to enrollment and needed resources
- Sign and adhere to an MNPS Data Contract
- Complete electronic reporting form
- Complete a Community Partner evaluation survey

### **How Project Reconnect worked:**

- Once a community partner was identified, trained, and prepared to join the initiative, MNPS provided a targeted list of students and families to partners based on that partner's specific population or service area.
- The community partner attempted to contact or locate the families of these identified students to understand why they were not re-enrolled and assisted them with re-enrollment if appropriate.
- Partners explored barriers to re-enrollment that were experienced by the families and communicated back to MNPS through the Collaborative Referral System.

# **Project Reconnect Initiative Outcomes**

The Attendance A-Team developed ambitious metrics to assess its performance for the 2021 school year, including:

**20** community organizations will sign the MNPS data contract and become Project Reconnect Partners:

Due to various factors, the the A-Team fell significantly short of meeting this goal with just 6 organizations satisfying all requirements to become a partner.

**70%** of identified students are found and families or caregivers are successfully contacted:

**Approximately 47%** of calls made by Project Reconnect Partners were successful in contacting families. Language differences, disconnected phones, & family relocation were identified as challenges.

100% of families who are identifed by Project Reconnect Partners as needing resources are entered into the Collaborative Referral System.



Although the overall number of resource needs identified were relatively low, **100**% were entered into the Collaborative Referral System.

In total, 79 students were re-enrolled as a result of the collaborative efforts of Project Reconnect Partners with Metro Nashville Public Schools.

A total of **649** students were identified by MNPS as missing after the first 10 days of school. Of those, **324** names were shared with Project Reconnect Partners while the others were managed by Truancy Compliance Officers.

Were apprehensive due to COVID, and others were confused by the transition from virtual to in-person. Language barriers also played a big part for some. As a Project Reconnect partner, we got to be a resource for parents to help them navigate a system they were not familiar with.
