## TOP RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STRENGTHENING STUDENT VOICE

### 1. Commit to Student Voice as a Core Value:

- Establish a shared definition of student voice within the school community.
- Communicate its importance through policies and practices.

### 2. Build Structural Support for Student Engagement:

- Create student-led advisory groups and strengthen existing structures such as student councils.
- Provide professional development for educators on facilitating student engagement.

### 3. Ensure Inclusivity and Representation:

- Identify and address barriers to participation for underrepresented student groups.
- Develop policies to promote equitable student involvement in decision-making.

### 4. Develop and Support Student Voice Champions:

- Designate educators and students as advocates for student voice initiatives.
- Provide training and peer mentorship opportunities to enhance leadership skills.

### 5. Measure and Sustain Impact:

- Develop feedback loops to ensure student input translates into action.
- Regularly assess and refine student voice initiatives based on measurable outcomes.
