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1. TIMINGS

Sunday 8 Feb: Set up Day

We encourage exhibitors to come to the Fair to bring/check your wines/spirits on Sunday 8 Feb between 2pm – 5pm

Wine Paris will open to visitors:

It is mandatory that someone from each stand is present during opening times.

Monday 9 Feb: 9am - 7pm
7-8pm - 'UNSIGNED. Meet & Drink'
Tuesday 10 Feb: 9am - 7pm
Wednesday 11 Feb: 9am - 5pm

2. LOCATION:

UNSIGNED. will be located in Hall 4, The International Hall. Stand number C279 (the same physical location as in 2025).

3. GETTING YOUR WINES/SPIRITS TO THE FAIR:

a. USING THE LOGISTICS PARTNER:

W&S Logistics is the recommended logistics partner (as for previous editions). You should contact them direct if you wish to use them.

First you need to make a quotation request using the document QUOTATION REQUEST

When you agree to the quote, you use the labels for the boxes and send the wines/spirits to the address indicated in the document + you need to include an invoice and packing list (there's a model to follow in the document).

The contract with W&S Logistics company is made directly by you and you are responsible for the payment to them as well.

On Sunday, W&S Logistics will deliver our pallets, and the UNSIGNED. team will be there to receive them. We won't be able to check if the correct number of boxes has been delivered, that's why we recommend you come on the Sunday from 2pm to 5pm to check this and take any necessary action.

b. DELIVERING YOURSELF:

If you are delivering to the Fair yourself by car

You need to register to have access to the official car parks and other delivery areas. Please do this by following this link:

Please note that registration is MANDATORY and that you won't be able to access on the day without pre-registration.

When you have access to the exhibitor zone on the Vinexpo system please double check the rules and regulations for personal delivery for this specific show.

c. USING YOUR OWN COURIER:

You can use your own courier but YOU have to be on the stand, or in a designated delivery zone to receive the delivery yourself.

d. USING YOUR COUNTRY'S GENERIC BODY

If your generic body is also exhibiting they may allow you to join their consolidated shipment – it's worth asking as this transport method may be the less expensive

In all cases it is YOUR responsibility to ensure your wines get to the show in time.

4. HOW MANY BOTTLES TO BRING/SEND:

You certainly know how many bottles you usually use at an International Fair, but please bear in mind that our storage space is limited. Please keep your total stock below 60 bottles per stand.

- We suggest a maximum of **10 skews per stand** (bearing in mind the size of the counter).
 - We suggest a maximum of **6 bottles per skew** unless you are showing only a few products - then you might need more.
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5. ADDING YOUR DETAILS AND INFORMATION ABOUT EXHIBITING ON THE WINE PARIS WEBSITE

Once you have paid for your stand, you will receive an email from the Vinexpo team to access the online system (profile + business matching platform) as we have registered you as our co-exhibitors. The email used is the one you gave us as your main email – so please pass on to all the team.

You will have access to 2 accounts, please note the ID and password are the same for both accounts. The email is the one you provided at the time of registration. If you already have an account with Wine Paris, you can use your existing login and password, or use the forgotten password option. If you are registering for the first time, or if your email address is not recognised, you will need to create a new account (using the 'forgot the password' option as well).

1. **Administrative account:** Your exhibitor account access: [WINE PARIS 2026 - Devenir Exposant](#)

This account is where you will manage your participation, find useful information (checklist, FAQ, etc), download your exhibitor badges, send your e-invitations to your clients (available beginning of December), see your stand location + stand number (available by end of December (see below too), access the online store to purchase optional items (extra badge, badge scanner, etc).

2. Catalogue page & networking account: Access link (right hand side of the page): [Home - Wine Paris - Vinexposium](#)

This account is where you will be able to:

- o complete your company catalogue profile
- o add your team members
- o access the meeting service platform to pre-plan meetings with registered buyers ahead of the show

To access this platform: connect to your admin customer account and edit your profile. Judy may have refined the English of your presentation text, so you may want to use it (it's on our [Wines Unearthed/UNSIGNED. website](#)).

Make sure that you really give as many details as possible so you can be easily found by visitors.

3. **Changing your page on the Wine Paris website:** Please access the Vinexposium Webinar with explanations on how to do this.

4. **To edit/order your badges**, please log in to your Exhibitor Area. Then, go on « **Badges & invitations** » tab:
5. Also in this section you have invitations to distribute to potential clients if needed

Next steps for you:

- Complete your online catalogue profile as soon as you receive the email from the Vinexpo team (description, team members, etc). You will be informed when the match making option is open and you can use it until the day before the fair.
 - Send your invitations (the platform is opening shortly as well, and you have time to use this)
 - Use the banner kit to personalise your email footer with your stand number
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6. ABOUT YOUR STAND

Your stand will be fully built with:

- o an unlockable counter
- o branding on the front of your counter*
- o branding above your counter (company name, your country's flag and your stand number)
- o a shelf at the back of your stand
- o a high stool
- o bin
- o corkscrew
- o spittoon
- o 3 drop stops
- o bottles of water
- o 12 glasses that will be washed 3 times a day – it worked perfectly this year even if it sounds like a small number of glasses
- o one large table top ice bucket. If you want more please order via the Vinexpo platform.
- o ice
- o daily cleaning

Storage:

The UNSIGNED. space will include a shared lockable storage area with running water and fridges. We will be allocating fridges and floor space for groups of exhibitors to share. There will be space to store spare wines/spirits in your own boxes. There will also be hangers for coats.

Security of your tasting equipment:

At the end of each evening, you need to empty your ice bucket and spittoon (in the UNSIGNED. storage area) and you **MUST** put your ice bucket, spittoon, spare bottles from the stand and all your tasting equipment in the storage area as there is no way to keep all this safely on your stand when the Fair is closed. Anything you lose you will have to pay for.

THE IMAGE FOR THE FRONT OF YOUR COUNTER: DEADLINE 12th December

Please send Sílvia the image you want for the front of your counter. It can just be your logo, but we think it would look much more impressive if you send her a photograph that

Format of the design:

- It has to be sent to Sílvia in one of these formats **.eps, .ai or high res pdf**. Any other format will be refused, so please make sure you really follow these indications.
- Please note that we won't be re-designing anything and the file you will send us will be the final to be printed, so make sure your logo is incorporated into your picture, if that's your wish.
- The final design will be printed on pvc in a **0.9m x 0.9m format**, so that's the size your designer needs to consider when producing this file.

Please make sure Sílvia receives these files **before 12th December**

NO Roll-up Banners: Because you have this branding opportunity on the front of your counter, please DO NOT bring roll-up banners as we won't allow them to be displayed.

7. UNSIGNED. TASTING BOOKLET:

We'll create and print a small exhibitor booklet using the information from the exhibitor questionnaire you have already filled in, but with no list of wines/spirits. So make sure you bring and print your product list + your price list.
