

STORY SHARING IN SMALL GROUPS

Prompt:

- **Share where you are at** in the solutions development process and where you are headed.
- **Go a little deeper into the story to highlight the connections between the harvest and the weave** - how are you hoping to harvest the right community insights and weave them into something that facilitates action?

Actively Harvest & Weave:

- Each of you will be sharing your own story but when we get back from the breakout, **you'll each also be responsible for weaving a narrative (1-3 sentences) about where the group is at and where you are headed** when it comes to solutions development.
- **So, during the breakout, listen** for the threads of connection across your three stories, and/or the defining distinctions between them.

SOLUTIONS DEVELOPMENT

- Community-driven assessments to understand community strengths, assets, threats, and challenges
- Examples of how other communities have addressed similar issues

GATHERING INFORMATION

PRIORITY SETTING

- Aligning on the issue areas that people are willing to organize around

IDENTIFYING + PROTOTYPING SOLUTION(S)

- Getting concrete about the specific solutions that address the root cause of the problem and build on community strengths

DEFINING THE PROBLEM

- Story sharing around how people are impacted
- Root cause analysis
- Using data to understand the patterns across lived experiences

VISIONING

- Group formation around a shared vision and values
