Day 1 | Wednesday 1 April - *Negombo*

Late evening arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport, where we will be met and transferred the short distance to the beachside town of Negombo for a comfortable overnight stay before our touring begins in earnest tomorrow.

Day 2 | Thursday 2 April - *Dambulla (B,D)*

After a leisurely breakfast we will depart for the historic capital of Anuradhapura, with a visit to the Dambulla cave temple en route.

The Dambulla Golden Cave temple is a vast isolated rock mass – 500 ft high and a mile around the base which dates back to the 1st century BC. King Walagamba spent 14 years' exile (from Anuradhapura) in the cave during his reign from 103BC-77BC.

Our home for three nights is the utterly splendid Heritance Kandalama designed by renowned architect Geoffrey Bawa, and set in 211 acres of protected forest in Sri Lanka's cultural triangle. To visit and stay here is a special treat.

Day 3

Friday 3 April - *Dambulla (B,D)*

This morning is at leisure – yours to enjoy the amenities of our beautiful resort.

In the afternoon we will take a 90 minute drive to visit the ancient city of Anuradhapura, documented as the first city in Sri Lanka, and dating back to 4th century BC. During this time, Buddhism became the established religion of the country, signified by the Jaya Sri Maha Bodhiya and other temples and ruins throughout the town.

Saturday 4 April - *Dambulla (B,D)*

Today we will take a short drive to visit Sigiriya Rock, an ancient rock fortress and palace built by King Kasyapa in 5th century AD. It served as the capital of the kingdom for a brief period. Today it is famous for the Sigiriya Frescoes found on the rock-face, and it is also an iconic climbing spot for visitors. Those among us with the energy to do so will have an opportunity to make the climb.

The garden provides an opportunity to learn about the various spices grown on the island, such as cinnamon, pepper, cardamom and cloves. Today's activities commence with a visit to the Peradeniya Royal Botanic Garden located close to Kandy, and one of the most expansive and beautiful in Sri Lanka. Spanning more than 60 hectares the garden is home to a vast variety of tropical plants, orchids, and towering trees. There is a renowned royal palm avenue, and orchid house.

For a complete change, our next visit will be to the Temple of the Tooth Relic, located in Kandy, and one of Sri Lanka's most sacred Buddhist sites. The temple houses the revered tooth relic of Lord Buddha and is an important pilgrimage destination, as well as a beautiful example of the distinctive Kandyan architecture.

This evening we will enjoy a vibrant and colourful dance show featuring traditional forms of Sri Lankan dance, rhythmic drumming, and elaborate costumes.

As the name suggests, the hotel was once a 19th century tea factory and has been stunningly converted into luxury accommodation in this very special part of Sri Lanka – often called Little England.

PAYMENTS

CONFIRMATION OF YOUR BOOKING

When we receive your booking form and deposit we will immediately dispatch confirmation of your place on the tour. From this time a firm contract exists between you and Ramsgate Travel on the basis of our tour flyer and any amendments communicated to you.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE TOUR PRICE?

Your tour price includes all arrangements as outlined in the daily itinerary inclusive of accommodation, transportation, admission fees, hotel portage of one suitcase per person and services of a Ramsgate Travel Tour Manager throughout. Meals are included according to the legend as shown beside each day's activities; any additional meals are at your own expense and payable direct at that time. IF YOU CANCEL OR ALTER YOUR BOOKING

Our tour operator will levy a charge if you cancel once the confirmation has been issued, to offset costs incurred in preparation of the tour.

Charges vary according to the period of notice given - (fees are per person).

Up to 91 days before departure - loss of deposit.

Between 90 and 62 days before departure - 50% of tour cost.

Less than 61 days before departure - 100% of total tour cost.

HOST
