7 day / 7 night private summer tour of the beautiful capitals of Latvia, Estonia and Finland

Both Tallinn in Estonia, and Riga in Latvia, offer a rich blend of history, culture, and architectural beauty. Tallinn's Old Town is a medieval gem with cobblestone streets and well-preserved buildings.

Riga is known for its Art Nouveau architecture, a vibrant cultural scene and a historic market. Then we have beautiful Helsinki also situated on the shores of the Baltic Sea. Known for its high quality of life, Helsinki offers a rich cultural and design scene, a vibrant waterside market and distinctive architecture including the iconic white Helsinki Cathedral and the contemporary Kiasma Museum of Contemporary Art. The city is surrounded by beautiful islands, and the historic Suomenlinna sea fortress is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



Baltic Gems Itinerary

Day 1 | Date

- Arrival at Riga airport.
- Private transfer to the hotel.
- Remainder of the day at leisure until 5pm welcome drinks.

Day 2 | Date

- Explore the old town of Riga with a private guide.

Day 3 | Date

- The morning is yours to enjoy before an afternoon transfer, by private coach, to Tallinn - a journey of around 4 ½ hours. You will enjoy a little of the countryside of both Latvia and Estonia before our early evening arrival.

Day 4 | Date

- A day trip to the fabulous Lahemaa National Park with a private guide, followed by a medieval dinner.

Day 5 | Date

- This morning we will further discover beautiful Tallinn on a private walking tour with some free time to enjoy before we transfer to the port for our late afternoon ferry to Helsinki, a fun journey of around 2 hours.

- Explore Helsinki & Suomenlinna with a private guide.

Day 7 | Date

- Explore Porvoo, the second oldest city in Finland that is best known for its Old Wooden Town, charming cafes and boutiques, and the painted red-ocre riverside warehouses. The cobble streets lined with old dollhouse-like houses are embedded with excellent restaurants, handcraft and homeware shops, and galleries.

- Private transfer to the airport.

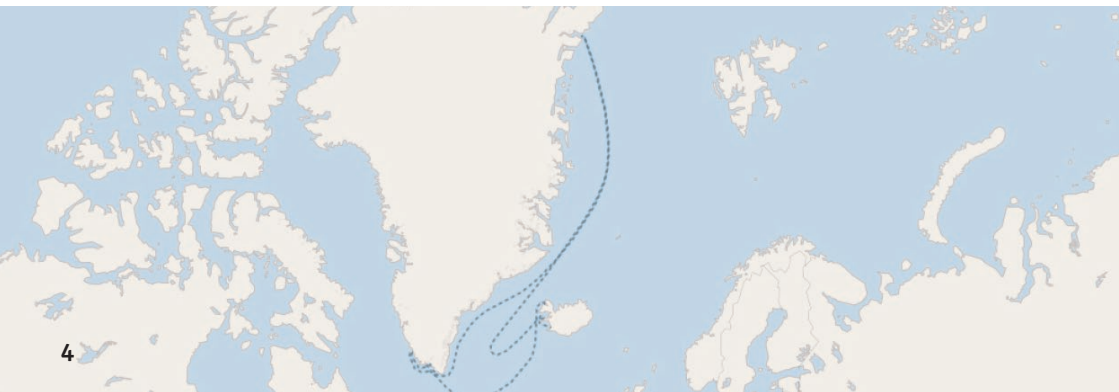

The city is noted for its unique architecture including the iconic Hallgrímskirkja church, and the truly amazing Harpa concert hall.



Southern Iceland Itinerary

Day 1 | Date

- Arrival at Reykjavik airport.
- Full day touring the famous Golden Circle visiting Geysir, Thingvellir and Gullfoss - a truly awe-inspiring way to begin your tour.
- Overnight Hotel Gullfoss. (B, D)

Day 2 | Date

- A day trip and ferry ride to the Westman Islands where the ferry trip alone is worth the effort! The Westman Islands is an archipelago off the southern coast of Iceland. The main island Heimaey, is known for its dramatic volcanic landscapes, most notably the Eldfell volcano, which erupted in 1973, shaping the island's current topography. The archipelago is a haven for birdwatchers, with puffins and other seabirds inhabiting the cliffs. Heimaey boasts a charming town with colourful houses, a maritime museum highlighting the local fishing heritage, and a unique gold course built on the lava fields created by the 1973 eruption. The Westman Islands and human resilience in the face of volcanic activity.

Day 3 | Date

- Today we continue to explore the beautiful southern region with visits to Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, Diamond Beach and Skaftafell before returning to our base in Vik.

- After a visit to Vik village, we will journey north to Reykjavik, visiting Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach, and the spectacular waterfalls of Skogafoss and Seljalandsfoss before our early evening arrival.
